The Minister of Popular Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, representing the Venezuelan State, indicated in his speech to the delegates at the XXVI Conference of the Parties of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP26), that "The Unilateral coercive measures are contrary to the basic foundations of international and environmental law".

The statement was made last Wednesday in the city of Glasgow, Scotland, in the United Kingdom of Great Britain. Lorca asserted that the measures imposed on the country

represent a very serious impact on the implementation of the 2015 Paris Agreement and the decisions taken at COP26, have "limited the ability to act in the face of the climate crisis and to adopt measures of both mitigation and the adoption of actions against climate change".

He pointed out that Venezuela ratifies its "multilateral commitment to the fight against climate change, and this reunion allows us to give a purpose to this COP26, to build a post-pandemic stage that takes considerations on the climate, because we are absolutely convinced that a better world is

possible and that we cannot leave anyone behind in this global mission".

"The climate crisis threatens all forms of life on our Mother Earth, human life, as well as the prospects for sustainable development of our countries. Climate change is one of the most serious and urgent global environmental challenges of our time, it is undoubtedly a decisive stage for multilateralism and a test period for the effectiveness of the Paris Agreement to achieve the collective goal of stabilizing global temperature", he stated.

Lorca said that the "celebration

face-to-face of the of the COP26 is an opportunity to renew the purposes that united us to reach the Paris Agreement in 2015, based on a common cause, a collective effort, where solidarity is the basis fundamental for climate action within the framework of the convention, its principles and objectives ”.

“From Venezuela we approach the fight against climate change from the principles of Ecosocialism, understanding that caring for the environment is intrinsically related to the model and sustainable production, with a broad and deep social content that seeks to overcome poverty, and the live well of our town,” he asserted.

He added that COP26 should make it possible to complete the implementation arrangements of the Paris Agreement “because the world expects concrete results, with ambitious mitigation goals from countries with historical responsibilities, credible commitments on the contribution of climate finance, incremental support for the adaptation goals in developing countries, financing for irreparable losses and damages ”.

Finally, Minister Lorca ended his speech with a phrase said by Commander Hugo Chávez in the city of Copenhagen, Denmark, on December 16, 2009, during the COP15, in which he said “If the climate were the largest capitalist bank we would have already saved it, let's not change the climate, let's change the system! ”.

Nine aspects in the context of the fulfillment of the Fifth Historical Objective of the Plan de la Patria 2019-2025, to counteract the effects of climate change:

1.- Even when we are under the imposition of unilateral coercive measures, we have delivered the updated and improved Nationally Determined Contribution (CND), reaffirming our commitment to the Paris Agreement. Highlighting among the proposed actions the reduction of 20% of our greenhouse gas emissions.

2.- A process of collective construction of a proposal for national legislation on climate change is being carried out, with an intergenerational and gender approach, with the incorporation of youth, boys and girls through the national educational system.

3.- Climate change is incorporated from the perspective of national planning, developing a social cartography and a map of vulnerability and risk.

4.- In terms of conservation, Venezuela has the largest tropical rainforest national park on the planet, the Caura National Park, with 7.5 million hectares, important in natural carbon absorption.

5.- Recently, President Nicolás Maduro, through a decree, strengthened the System of Protected Areas, which represents 43% of the national territory with the creation and expansion of new areas.

6.- In terms of forests, in Venezuela we have reduced the deforestation rate by up to 47% compared to the year 2000. It should be noted that forests in Venezuela represent 1.19% of the planet's forest cover, and 5.13% of America Latin.

7.- In the energy field, we have an energy matrix from renewable sources, which constitute 80% of the electricity that reaches homes and industries throughout the nation.

8- Venezuela has a National Drought Strategy, which has made it possible to identify the country's drylands and carry out an assessment associated with the vulnerability of extreme events in the country.

9.- As a response to adaptation and reduction of vulnerability to climate change, our country has reached the goal of 3,600,000 homes, benefiting families in vulnerable conditions ”.

The participation of the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism in the seventeenth edition of the International Book Fair of Venezuela (FILVEN) that took place in the spaces of the Federal Legislative Palace between 4th and 14th of November, can be described as successful.

In this edition of FILVEN, Minec, through the recently relaunched Amalivaca publishing house, presented 21 publications in a total of eight presentations during the fair within which there are two book baptisms. The titles presented revolve

around topics related to environmental issues, although it should be noted that there were a variety of options, from children's stories such as "The Plastic and the Turtle" to the book "Aristóbulo Istúriz: Entrañable Maestro" dedicated to the memory of Professor Aristóbulo Istúriz; going through the thought of Commander Hugo Chávez regarding the environment reflected in the text "Thought and Ideas of Commander Chávez on the Environment."

Likewise, the booklet "The Bolivarian Revolution in Defense of the Planet" was

presented where it will be possible to access in a digitized way in Spanish, through a QR code, the entire collection of copies exhibited during this Filven-2021.

This effort is part of the policies undertaken by Minec and the National Foundation for Environmental Education -Fundambiente- guided by Minister Josué Lorca for the reinforcement of training in environmental and ecosocialist matters, as expressed by the general director of Training for Ecosocialism and president of the National Foundation for Environmental Education (Fundambiente), Jesús Méndez, who indicated that the "degrees are part of the re-impetus and relaunch of the training, research and dissemination processes."

Forest firefighters and park rangers incorporated into the Safe Christmas Plan 2021

With the presence of servers from the Mission Tree Foundation, Forest Firefighters and the Civil Corps of Park Rangers of the National Park Institute (Inparques), the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), participated in the launch of the operation "Safe Christmas Plan 2021", which was held in Plaza Venezuela in the Venezuelan capital.

At the head of the initiation of the actions was the vice president of Citizen Security and Peace, and also Minister of the Interior, Justice and Peace, A / J Remigio Ceballos Ichaso, who explained that the mobilization is carried out simultaneously and in coordination with the security forces of all states.

"We are willing and ready to fulfill our constitutional tasks. Guarantee citizen security throughout the territory, in the different transport terminals, land, water, air, on the roads, with support also from the Risk Management System, for

emergencies and needs of the Venezuelan people," he said.

Ceballos called on the population to maintain all the measures required to combat COVID-19 and prevent crime, for which they have more than 23 institutions nationwide, in coordination with the governors and mayors.

"We will be more than 133 thousand officials working and we will be implacable against crime. We will look for the criminals and we will put them at the order of justice. We have already started a process to strengthen our citizen security bodies to directly combat all types of crime," he said.

For his part, the deputy minister of Comprehensive Garbage Management of the Minec, Luis Palacios, pointed out that the participation of the Minec in the mobilization is because in 46% of the areas through which travelers travel in seasons such as December, they are Surfaces

under the custody of the Minec through Inparques.

"Inparques has great importance in the care of National Parks, in primary care, guides and conditioning to receive seasonal workers in the month of December," he said.

Palacios added that there are 2,400 Forest Firefighters throughout the country, who will be attentive to each of the primary emergencies and outbreaks of forest fires, with which the Venezuelan people can feel safe in each of the actions and visits that do to the National Park System.

"To the hikers, volunteers, to the family who wants to enjoy this December festivities, we are deployed at the national level in conjunction with the Ministry of the Interior, Justice and Peace, and the Ministry of Tourism, in order to timely serve the Venezuelan family in this December", he concluded.

Minec will supply supplies to recover five solid waste compactors and transporters in Táchira



They refine strategies to strengthen public services in the entity

The Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec) will supply inputs to recover five solid waste compactors and transporters in the state of Táchira within the framework of the work agreements made during the visit of the Sector Vice-Presidency of

Works and Services to the aforementioned entity.

The deputy minister of Comprehensive Garbage Management of the Minec, Luis Palacios, made the announcement at the García de Hevia Club of the García de Hevia municipality, in the Andean entity, during a meeting of the institutions attached to the Vice Presidency that coordinates the G / J Néstor Reverol, who is also the Minister of Electric Power.

Palacios made a balance before the assistants of the management of Minister Lorca in his appearance at the XXVI Conference of the Parties of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP26), which takes place in Glasgow, Scotland, a country

that is a member of the Commonwealth of the United Kingdom.

Also, Palacios agreed to carry out technical inspections of the Tachira landfills, among other actions.

Vice-president Reverol was accompanied by the appointed representative of Minec, the head of Transportation, Hipólito Abreu, delegates of the Hydrology of the Southwest Region (Hidrosouthwest), of the Anonymous Telephone Company of Venezuela (Cantv), Ministry of Attention to Waters, PDVSA Gas and PDVSA Gas Comunal, and by the candidate for Governor of Táchira for the United Socialist Party of Venezuela (PSUV), Freddy Bernal.

Environmental training

Minec held a workshop on nursery conditioning in Guarenas

The Ecosocialist Territorial Unit (UTE) Miranda of the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), developed a workshop on asexual reproduction, conditioning of nursery areas and weeding, in the 27 de Febrero urbanization, of the Guarenas parish, in the municipality Plaza del Estado Miranda.

With the course, the Minec proposes that the communities start the implementation of agriculture and the environment in the streets and cities.

In the induction, the use of organic fertilizer, the refusal of plastic bags, and the use of worms in the Educational

Unit "Menca I" were also discussed, where 56 species of plants were placed and transplanted, including ornamentals, such as coleus, curia and

Creole tulip, medicinal, such as atoverán, sangria, acetaminophen and valerian, and food, such as yucca.

Course on vermiculture

In the town of Izcaragua, in the Guarenas parish, the theoretical-practical workshop on "Earthworm as Culture, Ecological Practice of Soil Conservation and Recovery" was held, in which people from the community participated.

In addition to providing directions for the construction of the worm bed, the Minec donated about 100 worms to the community.

Awarded 49 adaptations of forest industries in Monagas



A total of 394 forest adaptation certificates have been granted throughout the country

With the certificates delivered this Thursday, the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), reached 49 Adaptations of Forest Industries in the Monagas state, with which they total 394 nationwide.

The information was released by the national coordinator of the Ecosocialist Territorial Units (UTEC) of the Minec, César Solís, who was accompanied by the general director of Forest Heritage of the Minec, Walther Chacón, representatives of the Public Ministry (MP) and members of the Environmental Nursery of the Bolivarian National Guard (GNB), stationed in the region.

Solís stated that the national days for adjustments are due to the fact that “we have a single

instruction issued by our president Nicolás Maduro, who has been vigilant of us for the fulfillment of this mission, which is to strengthen and start Engine number 11, which it is the Forest Engine”.

“After a technical study and some work tables together with the Ministry of Industry and the

Presidency of the Republic, we realized that in order to start the Forest Engine, adaptations had to be made to the Venezuelan legal system, which is the adaptation of all industries”, he indicated.

He pointed out that in the national tour the adaptation of 394 industries throughout the country has been achieved and “if we cannot adapt to the entire forest industry, small, medium and large, we cannot continue to advance”.

“This forestry engine is going to be divided into several stages, one of these is the legal issue that was resolved with the guidelines and now the adjustments. We go with the carpenters because we know that it is not only wood as a raw material, but that a group of products such as lacquer, nails, hammers, grinders and all that kind of thing is vital for the activity. For this we are about to launch a large national supplier”, he said.

93 adjustments granted in the eastern part of the country

A total of 93 adequacy certificates were awarded in the eastern part of the country during the past week. Added to the adjustments certified by Minec in Monagas state are 14 certifications delivered to logging entrepreneurs in Sucre state and 30 certifications in Anzoátegui state.

It should be noted that the

forestry engine is part of the 18 reactivation engines contemplated in the Economic Recovery Agenda promoted by President Nicolás Maduro and the Bolivarian Government in which this engine plays a fundamental role due to the capacities and potential in forestry matters present in Venezuela.
