Delivery of awards to the Forest Firefighters

Min Lorca: 1,185 fires have been fought during the dry season



In the activity, a balance of forest fires was carried out

The Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, together with the Sectorial Vice President for Citizen Security, and head of Internal Relations, Justice and Peace, A/J Remigio Ceballos Ichaso, offered a balance of the forest fires in the recently completed dry season, which was characterized by the presence of the atmospheric phenomenon La Niña.

From the headquarters of the Civil Corps of Park Rangers of the National Parks Institute (Inparques), located on Francisco de Miranda Avenue, in front of the Generalissimo Francisco de Miranda Recreational Park, east of Greater Caracas, the authorities read and also imposed distinctions in commemoration of the International Day of the Forest Combatant, to members of the Forest Firefighters, Park Rangers, Civil Protection (PC) and volunteers of the rescue forces.

Ministers Lorca and Ceballos were accompanied in the presentation of the balance of the incidence of forest fires, the mayor of Caracas, Admiral in Chief, Carmen Meléndez, and the Head of Government of the Capital District, Nahum Fernández.

Minister Lorca indicated that a total of 10,224.65 hectares were affected by forest fires in the period, of which 5,840 correspond to areas under a special administration regime, which includes National Parks and Natural Monuments. Outside the protected areas, 4,383 hectares were impacted.

Regarding the number of events, the head of Ecosocialism commented that 1,185 were presented, of which 391 occurred in the protected territories and 794 outside these sites.

Likewise, he announced that of the affected hectares, 47% were in low vegetation, 40% in me-

dium and 13% in high, something that the minister highlights because "when a forest fire occurs, we seek to protect the high ones because they contain a high degree of biological diversity. in her".

Lorca affirmed that normally when the savannahs and thickets are burned there is not a great loss of diversity and that is why he makes the differentiation, considered by the authority as very important.

He said that in the last two years there have been losses in forest fires due to the La Niña period. In 2021 there were 905 events, now 1,185 and in 2020 1,878 events.

Minister Lorca pointed out that President Nicolás Maduro has been a passionate protector and enthusiast of strengthening the bodies that protect nature, and cited the President's instruction in April 2019 to increase the number of forest firefighters and park rangers "to guarantee effective protection of nature.

The ceremony

The act served to officially reopen the headquarters of the Park Rangers, subject to beautification of exteriors, arrangements of the perimeter fences, offices, kitchen, rooms, placement of new electrical wiring and Cantv.

Likewise, at the ceremony, recognitions were given to 18 personnel including Forest Firefighters, Park Rangers, the Bolivarian National Guard Air Command (GNB), National Civil

Protection, El Hatillo and the Capital District, and people from the rescue groups La Julia, Caracas, Catuche , Guayana and Brif 42.

For his part, A/J Ceballos stated that the Forest Firefighters and Park Rangers are part of the Unified Command against Forest Fi-

res and the National Risk System, "a great team that works to protect the people and the environment".

He said that the La Niña phenomenon is extending and the finished dry period was characterized by a lot of cloudiness and some rains, "which con-

tributed to the control effects".

Ceballos announced that scientific rigor must be applied in order to improve all firefighting platforms, "preparing for the next dry period, leveraging peace quadrants as a fundamental strategy to guarantee citizen security".

National Tree Day

National reforestation day held

This May 29, within the framework of the National Tree Day, a national day was held for the different ecosocialist forces such as the Guardians of the Tree movement, the Brigades against Climate Change, Park Rangers, Forest Firefighters, youth movements, social movements, Socialist Party Kingdom of Venezuela, among other organizations, in order to launch 100,000 seed supplies of different species of trees in the country.

This activity is part of the tree week, which will start on Monday, May 30, in which the National Reforestation Plan will be reinforced through the 1 tree-1 student program, with which it is expected that 324,000 future High school graduates, with the accompaniment of the Ministry of Popular Power for Education, join the reforestation work as protagonists of these actions that are also part of the 16th

anniversary of the Tree Mission.

This information was detailed by the Minister of Popular Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, in the reforestation activity carried out in the Cacimbo sector of the Waraira Repano National Park, in

which 8,000 avíos were launched and 400 trees were planted. different species. This activity is part of the National Reforestation Plan whose goal is to plant 10 million trees this year.

The Minister of Popular Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, announced the financing of the first 40 smallholdings, with the support of the Federal Council of Government, as part of the Family Agroforestry project of the National Reforestation Plan 2022-2023.

The statement was made by the head of Ecosocialism in the facilities of the Manuel Palacio Fajardo Technical High School located in the 23 de Enero parish in Caracas, where the productive work day led by the president of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Nicolás Maduro, took place.

The National President indicated that he was notified of a plan that contemplates that each student who graduates from high school establishes a plant for the Homeland, which would mean more than 320,000 copies "in homage to the Pachamama and part of the environmental conservation strategies that carries out the Tree Mission and the portfolio for Ecosocialism".

Minister Lorca indicated that the National Reforestation Plan has as a general goal for this year, the placement of 10,000,000 trees and with the next high school graduates 324,000 plants. However, the goal with basic education students is to establish 7,000,000 trees.

In this regard, the National President pointed out that "it is the student, communal power, who will reborn the country", while observing seedlings of avocado, coffee, soursop and araguaney, in addition to fruit seeds.

"We have to relaunch the Tree Mission. We have to go to a process of replanting and replanting the country, a green country. We have to have a guaranteed green Venezuela", said the Head of State.

At the exhibition, Minister Lorca commented that the Federal Council of Government, together with the Ministry of Communes, received the equipment to be assigned to the first conucos, whose initial

objective is the production of 25,000 plants, which represents one million of fruit trees to face the economic war.

The National Reforestation Plan 2022-2023 (PNR 2022-2023), is promoted by the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), through the attached entities Fundación Misión Árbol, National Institute of Parks (Inparques) and the National Company of Reforestation (Conare), and provides for Family Agroforestry, an agricultural production project that goes to the bosom of the family.

Inaugurated data center with international standard

As a result of the agreements established between the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec) and the Amazon Cooperation Treaty Organization (ACTO), a data center with international standards was inaugurated.

The General Director of Information Technology and Communication at Minec, Giovanni Bagnarol, explained that "this initiative aims to house the servers in a data center that has international standards".

Minec headquarters, which was attended by the director of Political Coordination Mechanisms for Multi-

lateral Issues of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Jackeline Mendoza, who expressed her satisfaction at being present during the act and work again with ACTO, waiting for the best results.

Likewise, the coordinator of the ACTO and the Amazon Regional Observatory, Mauro Ruffino, highlighted the pleasure of being in Venezuela and congratulated the Minec team for the successful results that have emerged

Ruffino stressed that ACTO is willing to welcome new projects in terms of conservation and preservation of the Amazon with joy.

They hold the First National Seminar on climate change and its effects on the world

During the First National Seminar on "Climate change and its effects on the world", the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism explained the challenges facing climate change, what actions it has taken and the forecasts for the atmospheric phenomenon .

Mention was made of the findings contained in the sixth report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), which brings together 76 countries that have carried out a series of research and monitoring works on the effects of climate change in the world.

The document relates that there are many changes observed in the climate that are unprecedented in hundreds of thousands of years of history. Likewise, it points to the rise in sea levels that cannot be reversed immediately and will only occur after centuries or thousands of years.

It also includes estimates of the temperature increase of more than 1.5 degrees in the coming decades, for which they suggest actions for the substantial and sustained reduction of carbon dioxide and greenhouse gas emissions, which would allow curb the effects of climate change.

In addition, it refers that the emissions of these gases come from human activities and are responsible for an approximate warming of 1.1 degrees from 1850 to

0 and it is expected that in the next 20 years it will reach 1.5 degrees.

The report's projections indicate that there will be an increase in heat waves, the hot seasons will lengthen and the cold seasons will shorten, something critical for agriculture and health.

Scenarios in Venezuela

Based on the considerations of the Second National Communication on Climate Change, the behavior of temperatures was estimated, which simulates values in the March/May quarter of 32.5 degrees for the year 2090, given that the average annual temperature is 27.5 degrees, which represents an increase of 5 degrees.

Regarding the impact of climate change on precipitation, it is indi-

cated that there will be a reduction in annual precipitation in the basins of the region, with some exceptions.

Regarding water resources, the scenarios indicate a decrease in surface runoff and therefore a reduction in average annual flows, as in the case of the Caroní River, a tributary of the Guri reservoir , which may present anomalies of -11% by mid-century.

Actions of the Bolivarian Government

The speakers listed the measures that the Minec and the Bolivarian Government have taken such as updating the nationally determined contribution of Venezuela, a document that records the contribution of each of the country's ministries and institutions with respect to their relationship with the environment.

Similarly, the creation of the Presidential Commission against Climate Change, which is in operation, was mentioned. The appointment of the designated national authority for the Green Climate Fund, chaired by Minister Josué Lorca.

The constitution of the Vice Ministry for the Conservation of Life and Biodiversity, a new instance, created from the Minec to address issues related to climate change, was recalled.

The creation of the Youth Brigades against Climate Change was agreed, which represents a concrete force from the territorial point of view, which allows the policies in eco-socialist matters to be grounded. This movement brings together more than 3,000 young people.

Additionally, the improvement of reforestation programs was brought up through the Tree Mission, the launch of the National Reforestation Strategy that includes five aspects: the "One stu-

dent, one tree" program, "Family Agroforestry", "Reforestation in the main basins of the country", linked to the Reforestation Technical Tables.

The nation adopted a special communiqué on the environment and climate change as part of the XIX Summit of Heads of State and Government, the Bolivarian Alliance for the Peoples of Our America-People's Trade Treaty (ALBA-TCP).

The Vice Ministry of Comprehensive Waste Management of the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), held a face-to-face and online meeting with the coordinators of the area in the Territorial Units of Ecosocialists (UTEC), with the aim of reviewing the operation of the National Policy on the matter.

in the National Congress of Public Services will be fulfilled. Likewise, he reported that the strengthening of the channels of information and interaction with the workers who live in the regions continues, which allows the construction of the Ecosocialist Homeland to continue.

The vice-ministry of Comprehensive Garbage Management is made up of four general directorates: General Directorate of Management Planning for Garbage Management, General Directorate of Garbage Infrastructure, General Directorate of Garbage Utilization and the General Directorate of Environmental Quality Management, which are committed to the victory of the Bolivarian Revolution in the environmental policies directed by Minister Josué Lorca.

The actions directed from said instance contribute to the materialization of the Fifth Historical Objective of the Plan Patria 2019-2025: "Contribute to the preservation of life on the planet and the salvation of the human species".
