## Sworn environmental prosecutors of the company Supra-Caracas

The Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), Josué Lorca, swore in a group of workers from the Supra Caracas company as Environmental Prosecutors, in addition to delivering supplies and containers to the Caracas Mayor's Office.

The new prosecutors will be deployed throughout the Venezuelan capital, to bring an awareness message to the residents about the need to comply with municipal ordinances.

The head of Ecosocialism accompanied the mayor of Caracas, A/J Carmen Meléndez,

at the inauguration of a primary health center of the Mayor's Office, which will provide care in the specialties of gynecology and dentistry, as well as a pharmacy for company workers.

Likewise, to strengthen the solid waste collection activity in the city, Minister Lorca granted the Mayor's Office 32 tires, 8 batteries and 12 oil pans for collection vehicles, and 20 garbage containers.

## To ensure the environment "Conservando" program began in Caracas with the planting of Nogales

In the context of the National Reforestation Plan 2022-2023, which is carried out by the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), the "Conservando" program was started, with the symbolic planting of five trees of the Nogal de Caracas species, from the Pastora, Libertador municipality of the Capital District.

The beginning of the repopulation of the emblematic tree, was carried out at the entrance of Puerta Caracas, with the support of volunteers, public servants of the Ecosocialist Territorial Unit (UTEC) Capital, the Tree Mission Foundation and the Environmental Nursery of the Bolivarian National Guard (GNB), among others.

The species is endemic in the capital region, that is, its location is restricted to specific geographical areas of the Waraira Repano National Park, so it is more vulnerable and in danger of extinction, since they are found in small numbers, and their reproduction in different environments is generally more complex.

It is worth noting that the initiative is part of the strategic line drawn by President Nicolás Maduro Moros in "ensuring the right of the environment, city and public services", promoted by the administration of Minister Josué Lorca throughout the national territory.

# Minec starts Conserving program in the national territory

With the participation of the Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, the "Conservando" program began in the state of Aragua, which will have coverage throughout the national territory and is contemplated in the National Reforestation Plan 2022-2023.

The launch took place at the Rancho Grande Biological Biodiversity Museum, located in the Mario Briceño Iragorry municipality of the entity, a place where Commander Hugo Chávez once placed a saman specimen.



*Conservando will execute actions for environmental preservation*

"Conservando" seeks to carry out actions conducive to the preservation of forest areas and endangered species, in those territories previously intervened through projects developed by state teams.

Minister Lorca stressed that the purpose of the program is the articulation of measures and procedures for the conversation of the national forest asset.

For her part, the governor of the entity, Karina Carpio, indicated that Aragua is not only the cradle of the Revolution but also of conservation, and added that everyone should feel admiration for the trees, since in her opinion, this It contributes to the sense of care and belonging.

In addition, the entity's Single Environmental Authority, Ant-

hony De Benedictis, representatives of the National Parks Institute (Inparques), National Reforestation Company (Conare), Mission Tree Foundation, Strategic Command of the Environmental Nursery (CEGA) Aragua, brigades against climate change, members of the Conserving Program and the Directorate of Biological Diversity Aragua del Minec, who took the opportunity to plant cocoa specimens, for the defense of Creole genetics.

## Sucre

Likewise, the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), was deployed in Sucre state, to establish 15 forest trees on the banks of the Manzanares River. The species planted were: 10 apamates (*Tabebuia rosea*)

and five mahogany (*Swietenia macrophylla*), placed in the Ayacucho Park, with the support of the staff of the Misión Árbol Foundation, Gran Mariscal de Ayacucho Foundation (Fundayacucho), National Foundation for Environmental Education (Fundambiente), Ecosocialist Territorial Unit (UTEC) Sucre del Minec and the Ombudsman of the People (DP).

The purpose of planting apamates is to multiply the species in the state of Sucre since it is in danger of extinction. The activity is part of the "Conservando" program.

# Minec donated a thousand plants to 60 zones productive in Portuguese

As part of the activities agenda of the "Family Agroforestry" program, the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), delivered 1,000 plants, including coffee and cocoa species, to 60 productive patios of the La Bendición de Dios Collective, located in the Camburito sector, in the Araure municipality in the Portuguesa state.

From this donation, Minec interest in establishing an agroforestry system that allows the insertion of fruit crops with the support of community leaders in grassroots organizations emerges.

It is expected that the action will

consolidate a community social fabric of producers who contribute to the Ecosocialist programs carried out by the Bolivarian Government in harmony with the environment, but with sustainable use that advances towards economic and productive independence in the country.

## In Barinas

# Plantation of araguaneyes championed the plan Conservando

With the symbolic planting of araguaney trees (*Tabebuia chrysantha*) in the state of Barinas, the Conserving program was

officially launched in the entity, led by the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), provided for in the National Reforestation Plan 2022-2023.

Minec conservation program also motivates the population about the importance and care of tree species, both species in danger of extinction and forest relevance in the plains entity.

Hence, in the Bolívar square of Sabaneta de Barinas, the establishment of Araguaney trees took place, with the beginning of reforestation in the Alberto Arvelo Torrealba municipality.

While, simultaneously, in the Bolívar square in the center of the plains capital, a plantation of six forest trees of cedar (2), apamate (2) and acacia (2) was carried out.

Public servants from the Minec and its affiliated entities, the Fundación Misión Tree, the National Reforestation Company (Conare), the National Institute of Parks (Inparques), participated in the reforestations, along with officials from the mayor's offices, teachers, members of the Bolivarian National Police (PNB) and Youth of the United Socialist Party of Venezuela (JPSUV), among other volunteers.

## Minec and Insopesca propose a Single Ticket Office to streamline procedures

In order to streamline the procedures through a Single Ticket Office, representatives of the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), and the Socialist Institute of Fisheries and Aquaculture (Insopesca), set up a work table, to which spokespersons from the National Institute of Aquatic Spaces (INEA) joined.

At the meeting, the second to take place for such purposes, it was possible to shape the idea of how the authorization management process should be carried out, which will be broken down, justified and consolidated in a report that will be taken to those responsible for Minec, Josue Lorca, and Fishing, Juan Carlos Loyo.

The Vice Minister of Environmental Management Services of Minec, Hernán Toro, explained that "the proposal will be presented to the two Ministers, in a much clearer way to advance the issue".

## Conservando seeks the preservation of wooded areas and native species



*They planted 50 emblematic trees*

With the planting of 50 emblematic trees, the Conserving program began in the state of Amazonas, as part of the actions for the preservation of forested areas and endangered species, promoted by the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec).

At Paseo Atabapo, in the municipality of Atures, Puerto Ayacucho, reforestation with the rubber species (*Hevea brasiliensis*) was concentrated, while at the Minec Amazonas headquarters, native fruit trees of the copoazú species (*Theobroma grandiflorum*).

A large number of volunteers participated in the day, which was attended by the Minec servers and the attached entities, Fundación Misión Tree, National Reforestation Company (Conare),

National Institute of Parks (Inparques), together with the Inparques Civil Corps of Park Rangers and Environmental Nursery of the Bolivarian National Guard (GNB).

Likewise, officials from the Main Ecological Customs Office of Puerto Ayacucho, the Seventh Prosecutor's Office of the Public Ministry in matters of Environmental Defense, Public Defense, Tourism Secretariat of the Government of Amazonas and HidroAmazonas were protagonists of the reforestation.

Also, the Movement of Reenactors, Professionals and Technicians, as well as the Youth Brigade Against Climate Change, among others, joined the operation.

## Minec promoted a paper on the environmental impact of end-of-life tires

The Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec) continues with the training activities of eco-socialist awareness, for which it presented a paper called "Tires out of use and their impact on the environment: Venezuela case".

The talk took place in the Waraira Repano room of the sixth floor, in the main headquarters of the Minec, located in the South Tower of El Silencio, in the center of the capital, a place that it shares with the Universidad Popular del Ambiente Fruto Vivas (Upafv).

Leading the activity was the president of the United for the Planet Foundation, Julia Martínez, who spoke about the impacts generated by end-of-life tires (NFU) in Venezuela, as sources of

contamination from an optical, environmental point of view and atmospheric.

He pointed out that the NFU contribute to the pollution of the seas, because the rubber wears out and releases small plastic polymers, which usually end up as contaminants in the waters.

Martínez showed the polluting impacts produced by tires, in an

awareness action to take care of the environment. NFUs can be worked on by applying the 3Rs of reduce, recycle and reuse.

## Established 200 moriche palms in Maturín

As part of the actions to launch the Conserving program carried out by the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), within the National Reforestation Plan 2022-2023, 200 moriche palms (*Mauritia flexuosa* LF) were established in the El Lechón sector, located in the Maturín municipality of Monagas state.

Hence, the Minec forest conservation initiative seeks to articulate and consolidate measures aimed at promoting the recovery of the Moriche communities in the eas-

tern region, especially for their nutritional, tourist, economic and cultural value, among others.

Regarding the Moriche palm, it



should be noted that it is considered an emblematic species in the entity, which is in danger of extinction due to the indiscriminate action of man, mainly due to water pollution, logging and disproportionate burning.

Public servants from the Ecosocialist Territorial Unit (UTEC) Monagas del Minec, the Misión Tree Foundation, the National Reforestation Company (Conare) and Maderas del Orinoco, among other institutions, participated in the operation.
