More than 1,100 Metras are activated in the country

With the aim of advancing in the solution and consolidation of public services in the country, the People's Power Minister for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, participated in the installation of the First Meeting with the Commissioners of the National Network of Public Services (Renaser).

The event was led by the Sectorial Vice President of Public Works and Services and Minister for Electric Power, G/J Néstor Reverol, who explained that "Renaser is the revolutionary offensive in the face of the challenges the country is experiencing, with a higher level of articulation in the different expressions of Popular Power to adapt public services throughout the national territory".

In this regard, the head of Ecosocialism during his speech stressed that at this time, in the Vice Presidency and on the back of G/J Reverol, rests a large part of the responsibility of the 1 x 10 Good Government.

"Those responsible for Renaser in

each of the spaces are our ears, eyes and hence the importance of the articulation between these five Ministries and all the institutions that are responsible for guaranteeing public services in each of the states", he said Lorca.

He pointed out that the first thing to highlight "is the importance of the National Network of Public Services and the second to make the entire Ecosocialist Management team available, that even if it is only the issue of waste that is in the Vice Presidency, there is also the right to the city".

"In order to have a new, different Venezuela, getting ready, it goes through the entire National Parks System, on which the country's tourism rests. It happens because the streets are fixed, the water arrives on time, the electricity does not go out and that the schools, universities and the Health System are well", he affirmed.

He pointed out that "one of the demands they make is that the parks be in good condition, so that people go

on weekends with their children, recreate themselves in a correct, healthy and harmonious way, that has also become a service public and the right to the city embodied in the third vertex".

"The operational structure that is linked to you from the Ministry for Ecosocialism would be the Recycling and Cleaning Technical Tables (Metras), which we have relaunched this year and we already have 1,160 formed nationwide and 3,840 in the process of being formed", held.

Lorca asserted that Vice President Reverol assigned him a task, "which at first seemed easy to do and became a bit complicated because there was no manual in Venezuela to know how much waste costs in the country, how it is generated and how much a collected ton is worth" in a municipality and its value in a final disposal site.

"That work was indicated to us by Vice President Reverol two and a half months ago, and we already have a manual for mayors and governors, with the aim of guiding them. The manual will alleviate the payment of services in the field of solid waste collection. We are in a Venezuela that seeks balance and the fair price of things", he said.

The head of Ecosocialism ended his speech with a balance of the recovery of the garbage compacting collection units that are in the country.

"We counted 1,253 damaged compactors nationally for the year 2021 and at this moment we can say that we only have 690 units that require repair. The rehabilitation has been a job of the Federal Government Council with the new mayors, in their efforts to make cities beautiful", he concluded.

With simultaneous ceremonies

More than 500 forest firefighters received promotion degrees

With a main act at the Youth Monument in La Victoria, Aragua state, and similar simultaneous ceremonies in the entities, more than 500 members of the Forest Firefighters Corps of the National Parks Institute (Inparques) received promotion degrees.

In the central activity, in the Aragua territory was the Minister of Popular Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, the governor of Aragua, Karina Carpio, military authorities and regional firefighters, among other personalities.

"This ascent for us has a special and particular meaning: it is the first since the instruction of April 22, 2018, when World Earth Day was celebrated, and President Nicolás Maduro ordered the training of more park rangers and forest firefighters", he said Lorca.

He explained that the President's request was to "train 10,000 park rangers and the same number of forest firefighters, and from there we began a very close relationship with the National Experimental Security University (UNES)".

"From Unes came that litter that today there are more than 500 who are ascending throughout the country, to their immediate higher grade", he said.

He added that later, when they were sworn in on June 31, graduating the first forest firefighters and park rangers, it was a commitment and a crusade to go through each state talking to the

boys, because they came from the hardest times, times of economic war".

"When I talk about forest firefighters, I say that they give their lives for a higher goal: for nature. They give their lives for those who have no voice, who cannot defend themselves. They give their lives for the lives of others, for the future", he said.

Lorca stated that he recognizes the forest firefighters because they are one of the noblest bodies in Venezuela, as is the Armed Forces and the National Risk System.

"This Forest Fire Department engages in hand-to-hand combat against fire, who sees a mountain on fire and they do not hesitate for a second to leave their daughter, son, family, to go de-

fend the lives of others, who Sometimes they are not human beings because they correspond to biodiversity and our trees", he assured.

He maintained that they are aware that "there are many things to do, to work to improve and dignify. We have come in a growing process of vindication, of technification together with Civil Protection and the Ministry of the Interior, Justice and Peace".

"Every day we are more unified, committed, better trained and we will continue to grow to live up to history and ensure our country the fulfillment of the Fifth Objective, which is to guarantee life above all things, the human species and that of planet Earth in all its extension", he concluded.

In order for the institution to develop a chapter in an upcoming legal instrument, the Special Commission of the National Assembly for the Protection of Agave Cocui Activity held a meeting with the Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca.

Deputy Julio Chávez was at the head of the parliamentary delegation, explaining that the special commission is protective of the production of agave cocui, in the semi-arid areas of the states of Lara and Falcón, and is currently preparing a normative text for artisan work.

"We visited Minister Lorca to incorporate aspects of the legal instrument that is being promoted, which has to do with the development of the programs and policies of the Venezuelan State, in order to promote the important activity, which has an ancestral and artisanal character, that drives that the production is 100% agave cocui", said the parliamentarian.

He added that "the idea of this visit is that the Minec can develop a chapter, an article, to

promote from the ecosocialist vision in line with the plans and programs of the fight against desertification, against climate change and all public policies".

He pointed out as interesting that the Minec assents to the proposal "the creation of nurseries, institutes and organizations that promote scientific development that seek reforestation and accompaniment, and preserve the water macro -basins and avoid desertification processes that have advanced in the country".

"We want articles and chapters to be incorporated that promote and can stimulate with incentives, that help fight against climate change, desertification," he assured.

The deputy indicated that all the elements and initiatives mentioned "can be reflected in a bill that promotes the activity in harmony with the environment, and that of course guarantees the ancestry and artisan character, that it be 100% agave cocui, that protects to the producers, to the cocuyeros masters of the semi-arid Lara-Falcón, and be part of the public policies promoted by President Nicolás Maduro in the country".

Forest Engine will strengthen the Bolivarian Economic Agenda

In order to strengthen Engine Number 11 of the Bolivarian Economic Agenda, at the headquarters of the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), the Forestry Cabinet was installed in person and through videoconference, in addition to reviewing of the progress of the National Reforestation Plan 2022-2023.

Participating in the meeting room of the office were the Deputy Minister of Environmental Management of Minec, Hernán Toro, the General Director of Forest Heritage of Minec, Zoraima Echenique, the president of the National Reforestation Company (Conare), Adolfo Paredes, the president of the National Forestry Company (Enafor), José Díaz, the General Director of Training of the Minec and president of the National Foundation for Environmental Education (Fundambiente), Jesús Méndez, the First Commander of the Forest Firefighters of the National Institute of Parks (Inparques), Colonel Germán Gutiérrez and personnel from the Minec Audit Department .

form, spokespersons from the Institute for the Control and Conservation of the Maracaibo Lake Basin (Iclam), the Latin American Forestry Institute (IFLA), in addition to the directors of the entities attached to the Minec and related regional directorates with the area.

During her speech, director Echenique made a balance of three years of ecosocialist management, in addition to drawing a work route to follow for the consolidation of the objectives of the Reforestation Plan.

Minec held a videoconference on the ichthyofauna in the Manzanares River

In the continuation of the moments of instruction, the General Directorate of Training of the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), held a videoconference on the ichthyofauna in the Manzanares River hydrological complex, in the state of Sucre.

The exhibition was in charge of Sinatra Salazar, a speaker who presented the aforementioned work at the First Congress of Researchers against Climate Change, which took place last May, at the facilities of the Casona Cultural in La Carlota.

Salazar shared data from his studies in which he indicates the existing fish and species in the Manzanares, the importance of

these animals and what must be done so that the tributary maintains its conditions and diversity.

David Álvarez, Director of Dissemination of the Training Department, commented that topics such as the one that was exposed and others are treated weekly for those interested in the institution and outside of it.

"I extend an invitation to all those

interested to attend the cycles of cineforos and videoconferences that are held weekly on Tuesdays and Thursdays," he said.

The meetings take place in the Waraira Repano Hall located on the sixth floor of the Minec headquarters, in the South Tower of El Silencio, in the center of the capital, a space that is shared with the Popular University of the Environment Fruto Vivas (Upafv).

As a tribute to the notable architect Fruto Vivas, who physically disappeared in the last week of August, the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), decided to honor his memory with the projection of an interview made to the design professional by the journalist Walter Martínez.

The documentary piece was recorded at the Venezolana de Televisión (VTV) studios in 2016, and served as an appetizer for a conversation about the character of architecture led by the rector of the Popular Fruit Vivas University of the Environment (UPAFV), Juan Manuel Parra.

Parra commented that Vivas

in the audiovisual tells his story, in a review that included even his participation as a guerrilla in the 60s of the last century and millennium.

"He starts when he was just a boy and makes his first design without even having started studying architecture. And then, the other works that he is carrying out until reaching this moment, when he leaves us physically", he said.

He affirmed that "the legacy of Vivas is impregnated in the walls of UPAFV, in the hearts and minds of those of us who work here".

Minec Training Directorate, has the intention that the young people, who mostly filled the Celestino Flores Hall, can learn part of that history, that they carry in their hearts that experience of a man who became a symbol for this country. Eternal glory to Fruto Vivas!" he declared.
