Schools will plant trees for life every Tuesday

With the beginning of the school year, "Ecological Productive" activities began at the "Paz Castillo" National Educational Unit, located in the La Pastora parish of the Libertador municipality, in Caracas.

The practice will take place every Tuesday in the different campuses in the national territory, in an attempt to sensitize the educational community about the importance of contributing to the mitigation of the negative effects of the climate crisis, which does so much damage to the planet, in a sign that through small actions such as the commitment to plant a tree, they guarantee the future.

Likewise, it is expected to generate the inter-institutional articulations required for the territorialization of the reforestation policy promoted

by the Tree Mission and the Ecological Brigades, in coordination with the authorities of the Venezuelan educational sector.

At the same time, it seeks to consolidate the sense of co-responsibility of young people in school towards the conservation of forest heritage throughout the country, and transform young people enrolled in the Bolivarian Education System into social actors for the transformation of their respective territorial realities, towards the consolidation of the Ecosocialist Homeland.

During the meeting, various tasks were carried out, such as: the installation of the "One student, one tree" Program, included at the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year; the formation of the Ecological Brigades in the educational institution, with which

they highlighted the importance in the fight to mitigate the effects of the climate crisis; encourage the educational community to promote production through the strengthening of school nurseries and guarantee that each student fulfills the duty of planting a tree as a graduation requirement and certification of responsibility with life.

Jean Román, coordinator of the Brigades Against Climate Change, pointed out that during the activity some ecological bins were delivered, for the classification of the waste generated in the educational center, an agreement that reinforces the ecological vocation and awareness.

The Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, together with the Minister for Education, Yelitze Santaella, accompanied the development of the activity.

Minister Lorca and Mayor of Caracas inspected El Pinar Zoo

The People's Power Minister for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, and the Mayor of Caracas, A/J Carmen Meléndez, visited the facilities of the El Pinar Zoo, located in the El Paraíso parish of the capital.

The purpose of the inspection was to verify all the details of the rehabilitation of the infrastructure, in order to guarantee the public that the site is in optimal conditions for the visit.

The El Pinar Zoo, located on Guzmán Blanco Avenue, was the first in Caracas, occupies an

area of 7 hectares (ha) and was inaugurated on August 13, 1945, during the presidency of Isaías Medina Angarita.

Rehabilitation works and general repairs of the infrastructure and green areas were carried out on the site, the park's fauna collection was updated with the incorporation of new species, in addition to being provided with materials and supplies necessary for operation.

Its new objective will be to function as a Wildlife Rescue and Rehabilitation Center, in compliance with the decisions made at the II Meeting of Zoos, Farms and Aquariums last year 2021.

Launched 21.771 avios

Placed 416 trees in the protective zone of the Neverí River

Regarding the "Sembrando Vida" program, of the National Reforestation Plan 2022-2023, servants of various institutions and spokespersons of the organized People's Power, participated in the establishment of 416 trees in the protective zone of the Neverí River, Pequín sector of the Sotillo municipality, in Anzoátegui state.

The specimens, including fruit and forest trees, were placed by personnel from the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Fundación Misión

Tree, members of the Bolívar and Chávez Battle Units (UBCH) and the community in general, in what constituted an ecological activity aimed at recover and preserve the important hydrographic basin.

In the same sector, but in an area of difficult access for conventional reforestation, 21,771 avíos were launched, compacted in the Minec institutional nursery in Anzoátegui, whose units with sufficient substrate for the growth of plants in their initial stage, contained seeds of apamate, flamboyant, pionía, samán and acacia.

Last Monday, October 3, the People's Power Minister for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, led the commemorative events for the 49th anniversary of the National Parks Institute (Inparques), which took place in the Generalissimo Francisco de Miranda Recreational Park, located east of Greater Caracas.

During the ceremony, the Inparques staff who have completed between 5 and 30 years of service received recognition buttons directly from Minister Lorca, as well as words of encouragement to continue with the meritorious work.

"All the ecosystem services of a park is the *raison d'être* of Inparques and in these 49 years, with ups and downs, Inparques has stood up with the impetus, tenacity and heart of those who work in the institution, that is what that has sustained it," he said.

For his part, José Rubio, coordinator of Inparques in Aragua, with 29 years of service, said he was proud to be a worker at the institution, "a pride that other co-workers surely have as well."

Meanwhile, the director of National Parks, Hilda Ángel, stated that Inparques has a very important vision and mission at a national and international level.

"Everything we do is with faith because we know that we have a task that has a national and

international impact. I have been with the institution for 30 years and this one has 49. I have spent my whole life at Inparques, working with perseverance and tenacity to be able to give best of me," he said.

In this sense, Jenny Carrero, who has been working at Inparques for 25 years, commented that to work at Inparques one must have "a lot of love for nature, charisma and love for coworkers."

"I am eternally grateful to this institute that has given me everything, education, training on monuments and recreation parks," he assured.

Likewise, Leonardo Gómez, Captain of the Inparques Forest Firefighters Corps, said he was proud to belong to the institution.

"I am happy because the years of service of each official were taken into account. We will continue to give our best and I hope that you will always support us in the invaluable work we have done," he said.

Reforested areas degraded by mining in Bolívar state



Activity is part of the National Reforestation Plan 2022-2023

The Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), affiliated entities and regional institutions, participated in the reforestation with acacias of an area degraded by mining activity in the El Callao municipality of Bolívar state.

With the established specimens, in areas affected by mining in the former Domingo Sifontes Complex, 32,350 planted were reached and it is expected to reach 33,000.

The Vice Minister of Environmental Management Services of the Minec, Hernán Toro, was accompanied by personnel from the National Forestry Company

(Enafor), the Bolivarian National Guard (GNB) through the Environmental Nursery, Fundación Misión Tree, brigadistas Contra el Cambio Climate, Maderas del Orinoco, Government of Bolívar and the community of Nakupai.

Toro explained that the activity is a project that is part of the National Reforestation Plan 2022-2023, which includes reaching 50,000 acacias planted in sectors affected by mining in the Piar, Sifontes and Roscio municipalities.

"The species is fast growing, has an effective performance in degraded spaces and makes important contributions to the soil in its regeneration process," he said.

On the occasion of the week of the 49th Anniversary of the National Parks Institute (Inparques), an entity attached to the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), an ecotourism card was installed from the Galindo Park Ranger station in the Waraira National Park.

Through the file, the attendees, including staff from

the main headquarters of Inparques, the Civil Corps of Park Rangers and Forest Firefighters, managers of National Parks and Natural Monuments, carried out an anthropic and environmental evaluation of the route to the Ruins of Mestiati.

It is a place with remains of the construction of what was once a mansion, belonging to the Italian Count Adolfo Mestiati, who lived in the country during the 19th century.

Forest Firefighters participate in Motorized Defensive Driving course

With the presence of the People's Power Minister for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, the Sectoral Vice President for Citizen Security and Head of Internal Relations, Justice and Peace, A/J Remigio Ceballos Ichaso and M/G Carlos Pérez Ampueda, last Wednesday began in the national territory, the Motorized Defensive Driving Course, in which members of the Forest Firefighters participate.

The induction was launched at the Pajaritos Central Barracks of the Forest Firefighters Corps of the National Parks Institute (Inparques), with the aim that officers acquire additional skills in driving motorcycles, and thus consolidate attention in

emergency situations and disasters.

In this regard, the Vice President of Citizen Security, assured on his Instagram social network account, that the course takes place throughout the country "to strengthen the capacities of the National Risk System, to deal with emergencies and disasters that guarantee protection and life of the people".

Likewise, the A/J Ceballos Ichaso said that the training is part of the comprehensive training in firefighting and first aid that, added to the dedication, discipline, courage and sacrifice of the firefighters, strengthens the daily attendance "quickly and safe to the Venezuelan people".

Concludes Regional Preparatory Meeting for COP19 of the CITES Convention

On October 7, the First Preparatory Meeting of the Central, South and Caribbean America Region of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) concluded, which took place in Panama from Wednesday 5 present month.

The meeting aimed to prepare the member countries of the Convention for the next Conference of the Parties called the COP of the

Americas, scheduled to take place in November in the current host nation of the preparatory meeting.

In this sense, the Panamanian State called for the COP to be attended as a united America.

For its part, the Venezuelan delegation had the opportunity to present its technical interventions in relation to the proposals presented by the parties.

Minec conducts eco-workshop “Blessed animals and their anniversaries”

He added that it is hoped to sensitize those who witnessed the dissertation, about the importance of determining and caring for which of the species are representative of our culture, idiosyncrasies and beliefs.
