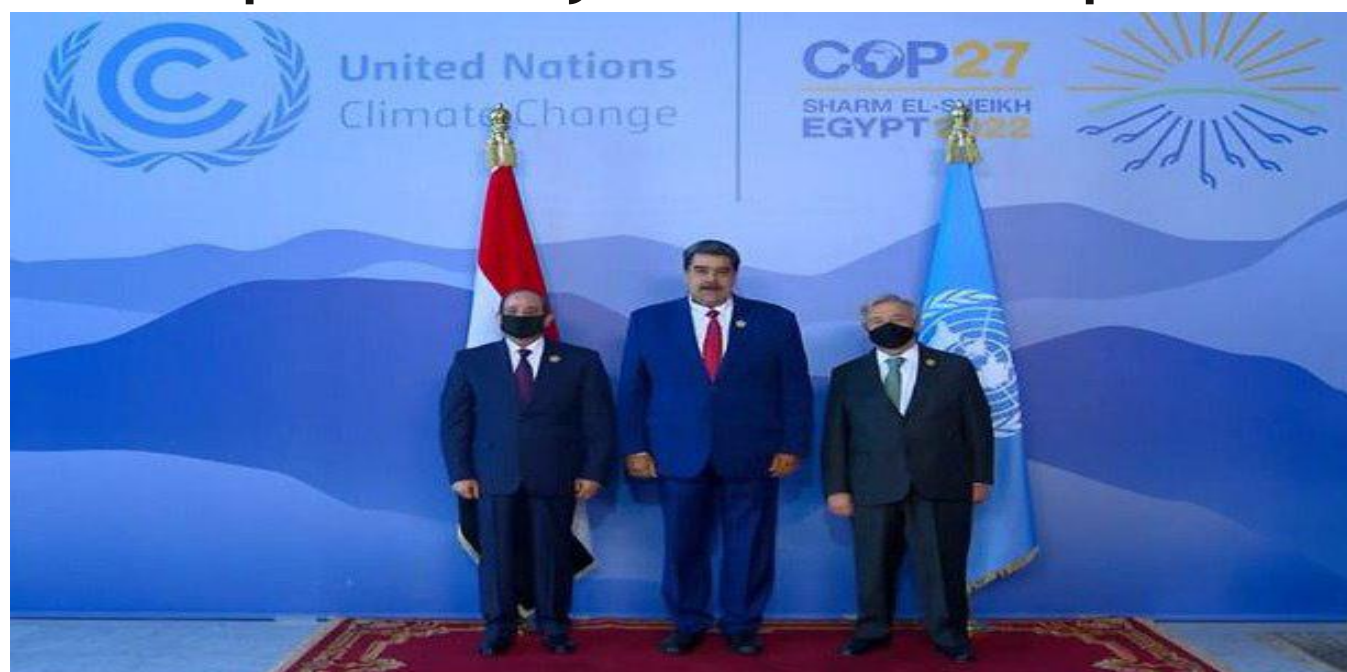

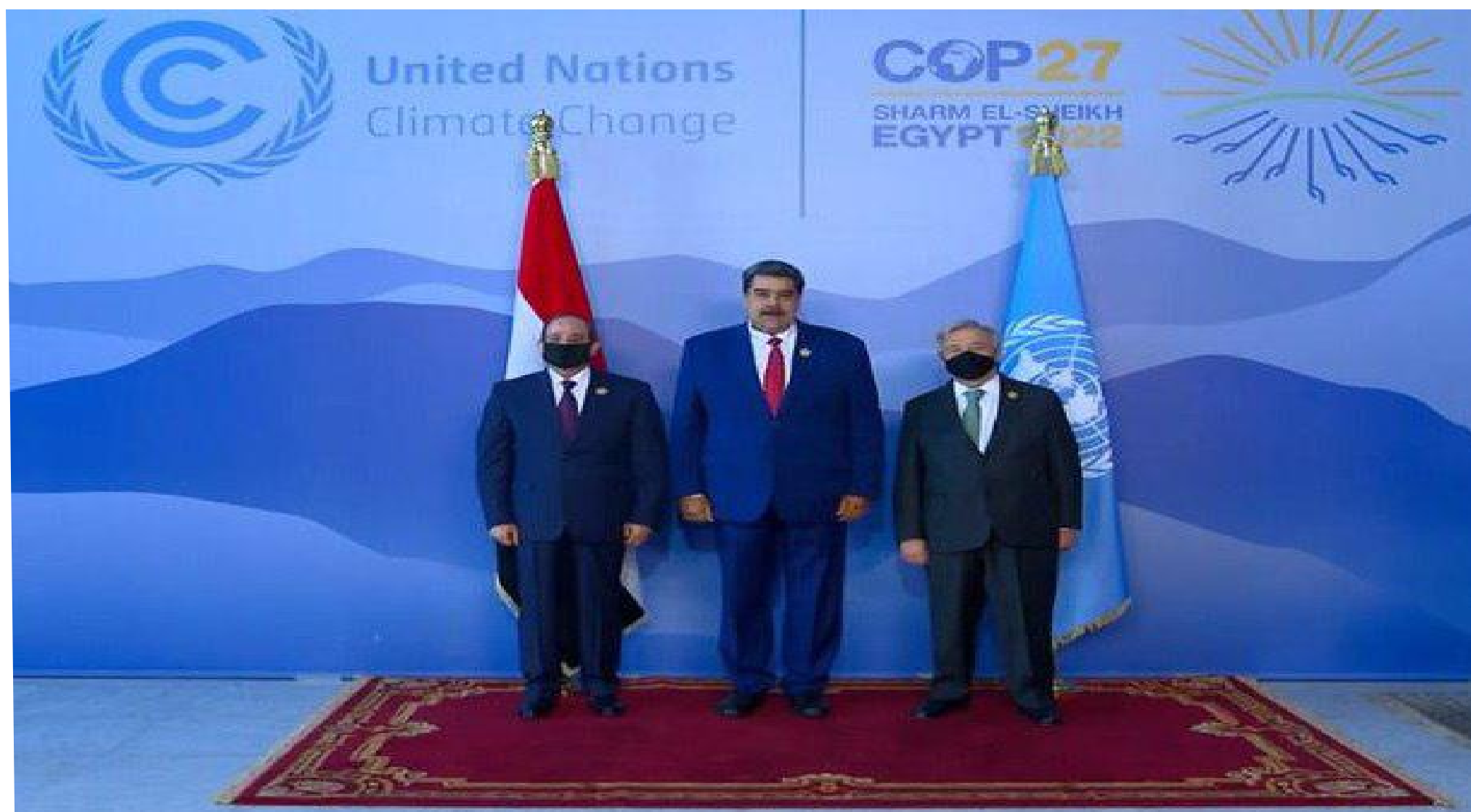

Venezuela advocates a common approach of the peoples of the South

Regarding his speech at the 27th Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP27) that takes place in the city of Sharm El-Sheikh, located in Egypt, the president of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Nicolás Maduro, carries the voice of the peoples of the South in defense of a humanistic and respectful model of life on the planet.

"Venezuela brings a firm position to accelerate the steps for the fulfillment of the agreements that have already been signed in the past and accelerate the processes so that the destructive capitalist model is replaced by a humane model, by a model that respects living conditions. in the planet".

President Maduro pointed out that the debate at COP27 should focus on what humanity can do to make a qualitative leap in terms of reversing the effects of the climate crisis.

The national president pointed out that it should be a common approach of the peoples of the South "to demand a change in the highly polluting consumer system of the United States and Europe."

COP27 opened this Sunday, November 6, under the premise of renewing and extending the commitments made in the 2015 Paris Agreement.

President Nicolás Maduro is accompanied by the first combatant Cilia Flores; the Vice President of Communication, Culture and Tourism, Freddy Náñez; the Chancellor of the Republic, Carlos Faría; the Minister for Ecosocialism Josué Lorca and the Minister of People's Power for the Office of the Presidency and Monitoring of Government Management, Jorge Márquez..

Sameh Shoukry elected president of COP27

Egyptian Foreign Minister HE Sameh Shoukry was formally

elected as COP27 President by Parties during the opening plenary, after which he called on countries to show faith in multilateralism over the next two weeks as to negotiate to meet the goals of the Climate Convention and the Paris Agreement.

Addressing climate envoys and delegates at what is considered to be one of the largest COPs in history in terms of attendance, COP President HE Sameh Shoukry said: "It is no surprise to anyone that the COP is being held this year, in a world that is witnessing political turmoil that casts a long shadow over all of our nations and has resulted in energy and food crises; however, these challenges should not be a reason to delay our collective effort to fight climate change. It is inherent in all of us in Sharm El Sheikh to demonstrate our recognition of the scale of the challenges we face and our strong determination to overcome them".

Venezuela demands a change in highly polluting developmentalist systems like the US

Venezuela supports the proposal of the G77 + China that contemplates the creation of a climate loss and damage fund, said the president of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Nicolás Maduro.

In statements to the Venezuelan media, upon his arrival in Egypt, the Head of State indicated that he agrees with this financial architecture.

"On the financial architecture, we agree with the proposal of the G77 + China so that the financing funds are met, especially for the mitigation tasks of the countries of the South."

Along these lines, he referred that "those who

are polluting today, pay, within the framework of the mitigation and recovery process."

He added regarding the position of the South American nation regarding the possible creation of a climate loss and damage fund that "the first thing we have to demand from the South of the planet is that there be a change in the highly polluting developmental systems of the North, Europe, from the United States.

He exemplified that with "the conflict in Ukraine, Europe has put aside and abandoned the plans to reduce the generation of greenhouse gases and begin to use coal excessively, they do not care about complying with the agreements that have been formed. , like the Paris Agreement sealed in 2015".

Venezuela participates in the COP14 on wetlands

A Venezuelan delegation participates in the 14th Meeting of the Conference of the Contracting Parties (COP14), of the Convention on Wetlands, known as the Ramsar Convention, an international meeting that will last until Sunday the 13th, in a hybrid way in Wuhan, China and Geneva, Switzerland.

Venezuela has five wetlands registered as Ramsar sites: the Los Olivitos Ciénaga Wildlife Refuge and

Fishing Reserve (Zulia); the Cuare Wildlife Refuge (Falcón); the Laguna de Tacarigua within the National Park of the same name (Miranda); Laguna la Restinga in said National Park (Nueva Esparta) and the Los Roques Archipelago National Park (Federal Dependencies in the Francisco de Miranda Insular Territory.

This Convention was adopted in the Iranian city of Ramsar in 1971, entered into force in 1978 and currently groups more than 170 countries.

1x10 Good Government

They install work tables to improve public services in Zulia



Territorial organization of the Venezuelan people is essential for Good Government

As part of the 1×10 of Good Government, the sectoral vice-president of Public Works and Services, G/J Néstor Reverol, held a work meeting in order to improve public services in Zulia state.

During the activity, the General in Chief was accompanied by the different ministers that make up this Sectoral Vice Presidency, who discussed the improvement of public services in the Zulia region.

Reverol, highlighted the territorial organization that the people of Venezuela have, for which he expressed the need to take advantage of this valuable tool to exercise Good Government.

In addition to this, he mentioned that the gasification works in the municipalities of Maracaibo, San Francisco, Lagunillas, Mara and Machiques de Perijá in Zulia state will be promoted again.

“We will also carry out major maintenance on the infrastructure of the Domestic Gas Transportation and Distribution System throughout the state and we are going to form 300 Recycling and Cleaning Technical Tables and we will install 12 Recycling Schools in the territory,” he specified.

Regarding electrical energy, he reported that a Comprehensive Lighting Plan for expressways in avenues is currently being developed, in addition to the comprehensive rehabilitation of aqueduct systems, pumping stations and water treatment plants.

In this regard, he recalled that the 1×10 of the Good Government is a novel system promoted by the President of the Republic, Nicolás Maduro, which allows a closeness with the people, so that they report what their needs are and provide them with solutions.

Shows signs of recovery

Tico Manatee arrived at the Bararida Zoological and Botanical Park in Lara



The animal was transferred from Margarita

The manatee named Tico, rescued by the Venezuelan authorities about two months ago, who was recovering at the facilities of the Waterland company on Margarita Island, arrived at the Bararida Zoological and Botanical Park, in Lara state.

The animal was transferred from Margarita in a Hercules-type four-engine turboprop cargo plane, operated by the Venezuelan Air Force, in which it was given the necessary care during the trip, to be received at the Jacinto Lara International Airport by the governor of the entity, Adolfo Pereira, and the Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca.

In this regard, the Larense president, Adolfo Pereira, commented that Bararida has a new friend "a young manatee, rescued by the Bolivarian National Armed Forces (FANB) and the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec)".

"He was sheltered on Margarita Island and transferred here, to his

new home in the Bararida Zoological and Botanical Park, where he will be in a beautiful space. It will occupy a swimming pool that had been unused for more than 17 years and that Tico is going to use for the first time", he said.

Pereira thanked the president of Bararida for his participation "for having put all the means so that Tico rests and stays healthy and alive."

For his part, the head of Ecosocialism, José Lorca, indicated that "the story of Tico has been reflected by different media around the world because it is one of the most protected species on the planet".

"This manatee has a history of approximately three months, when it was released in Brazil in early July. The animal became disoriented and sailed more than 4,000 kilometers to La Blanquilla Island, in the federal offices of Venezuela", he said.

He added that the specimen traveled through five countries and

"could not be rescued in Suriname, French Guiana or Trinidad and Tobago, and it was the Venezuelan Armed Forces together with the Ministry for Ecosocialism and Popular Power, represented by the fishermen and fishermen of the area who finally managed to rescue him.

The Minister thanked the Waterland company for having enabled its spaces to stabilize the manatee. "The animal had lost more than 50 kilos on the 4,000 kilometer trip, it showed lacerations and kidney problems detected when the first blood chemistry was done", he said.

"We believe this is one of the news stories of 2022 for science and nature lovers around the world. The manatee arrived with a gain of 37 kilos, is two centimeters taller, feeds on 30 kilos of fresh lettuce daily, and is also given vitamin supplements", he assured.

Lorca stated that "after 57 days in Margarita, Tico arrived at the Bararida Zoological and Botanical Park, a specialist center for manatee reproduction, to be maintained and treated".

Eight new specimens arrived in the country to strengthen the zoo system



Species: Kangaroo Wallaby, Giant Kangaroo and Matas de la Patagonia

In order to strengthen the National System of Zoos, the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), received eight specimens of the species: Kangaroo Wallaby, Giant Kangaroo and Patagonian Maras.

The animals arrived by air from the city of Woerden, the Netherlands, Holland, and will remain in quarantine at the Caricuao Zoo, to continue promoting "ex situ" conservation as an essential component of the conservation of biological diversity. .

Among the species is a male and female pair of Wallabies or Red-necked Wallabies, also Bennet's Wallabies (*Macropus rufogriseus*). From the Toledo Zoo, Madrid, Barajas, and are approximately one year old.

The Wallabi are iconic of Australia and there are more than 60 different species belonging to the macropod family, which means large legs. They are nocturnal.

Likewise, two Giant Kangaroos or Red Kangaroos (*Macropus Rufus*), a one-year-old male and female

pair, were received.

Likewise, there are four Patagonian Maras (*Dolichotis patagonum*), two males and two females. This specimen is a large rodent that can reach 16 kilos in weight, with long and thin legs, the rear ones being longer than the front ones. The forelimbs have claw-like nails, while the hind limbs are shaped like small hooves.

The body structure and the way of moving in jumps is reminiscent of hares, which is why it is commonly known by this name. Its fur is dense, greyish on the upper parts and lighter on the lower parts.

They run very quickly, although they only do so when they are in danger. When resting they adopt an unusual posture for a rodent, sitting on their hindquarters, with their forelimbs stretched out in the manner of a dog.

They live in burrows built by themselves or take advantage of those that were already excavated by other animals, which they later enlarge or retouch. They live in groups of variable number, from 3-4 to 40 individuals. They carry out their activities during the day.

Reptiles lack poison glands

Minec Zulia reinserted four Boas Constrictors into their natural habita

The Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec) reinserted four (04) specimens of wildlife known as "tragavenados" (Boa constrictor) to their natural habitat in the Burro Negro recreational park in the Lagunillas municipality, Zulia state.

The release of the snakes occurs, after having remained temporarily sheltered at the headquarters of the Ecosocialist Territorial Unit (UTEC) of the entity, under the veterinary care and evaluation of the regional Biodiversity team, with authorization from the General

Directorate of Biological Diversity.

This fact took place with the support and coordination of the Marabino firefighters, who rescued the reptiles in days past, because they were scattered in different places in the capital of Zulia, near water streams.

Importance of the Boa Constrictor in ecosystems

One of the characteristics that distinguishes this reptile is that they lack poisonous glands, since they feed on hunting lizards, rats or wild mice. Although they can be found hidden in abandoned places with food in houses.

According to veterinary studies, these non-poisonous wild animals have a value for the balance of ecosystems, especially for the biological control of other sick or weak species.

Therefore, the recommendation of the experts in their presence is not to mistreat these animals and promptly notify the regional directorates of the Minec, or members of the Environmental Guard or Fire Department, among other related authorities.

In this way, the servers activate the security protocols for their correct handling and thus guarantee the lives of wild animals as well as the inhabitants of the region.

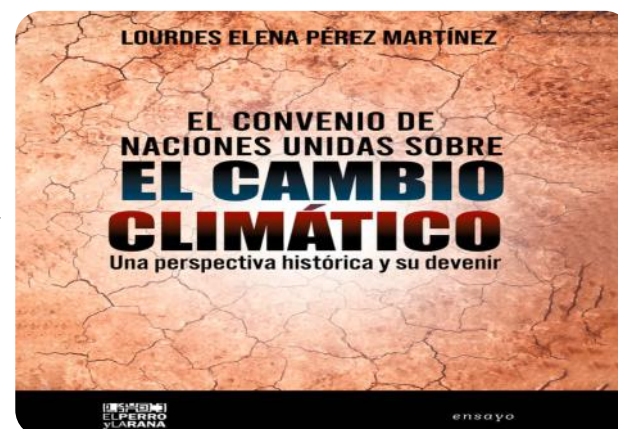
