Environmental Laboratory will be available to evaluate levels of gas emanation and contamination

The Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism relaunched the operation of the Institute for the Control and Conservation of the Lake Maracaibo Basin (ICLAM), where 11 strategic units were recovered.

The holder of the ecosocialist portfolio, Josué Lorca, led the activity together with the president of ICLAM, Armando Portillo; the president of the Maracaibo Lake Hydrological Office, Freddy Rodríguez, and the Vice Minister of Comprehensive Garbage Management of Minec, Dennys Guédez.

Portillo pointed out that the Lake Maracaibo basin is made up of the states of Zulia, Táchira, Mérida and Trujillo, territorial entities from which the tributaries and discharges that converge in the Lake come.

"We will carry out investigations at the Center, with which this Revolutionary Government assumes the issue of climate change, hand in hand with the people," he said.

The recovery process included: Rehabilitation of 90% of the environmental conditions of the laboratory, infrastructure, lighting, air conditioning.

-Execution of 80% of the physicochemical and bacteriological analyzes in water and sediment samples, as well as air quality evaluations for gas and particulate matter parameters.

-Rehabilitation of 100% of the environmental conditions of the CID information and documentation center and recovery of the

digitalization server, where the data of 20 years of scientific reports is stored.

-Placement of poly-shade mesh for saran in the shade area of the educational nursery, which will allow monitoring and control of the sustainable development of propagated seedlings, propagation and successful maintenance of 16,489 plants of 143 forest, medicinal, ornamental and fruit species in 14 corridors of the ICLAM educational incubator.

-Rehabilitation of 100% of the environmental conditions of the administration offices, conference room, which includes lighting and painting.

With this, the Environmental Laboratory was enabled, with all the necessary permits granted by the Ministry, so it will be available to the public, to the industrial park and to each of the companies in the country "that want to evaluate how their processes are, how is the contribution, the emanation of gases and the levels of contamination that could contribute", explained Portillo.

Additionally, in the institutional nursery of ICLAM, the educational aspect will be developed, mainly aimed at girls, boys and the entire population of educational centers, to try to carry that message of the phenomenon of climate change and the behavior of Lake Maracaibo.

Portillo added that the ICLAM nursery has among its objectives the mangrove reforestation of the entire coast of the San Francisco municipality.

Comprehensive Automated System of Administrative Procedures in Parks is in operation

The Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec) activated the Comprehensive Automated System of Administrative Procedures in Parks (Siapap) on its WEB portal, through which the processes related to authorizing and approving permits are automated.

The Siapap, an initiative of the National Parks Directorate of the National Parks Institute (Inparques), is adapted to the different activities carried out in National Parks, Natural Monuments and Recreation Parks, to lighten procedures and stimulate responses.

The traditional procedure contemplates the consignment of

the requests of the interested parties in the regional or national headquarters of Inparques, for evaluation of the technical teams and to prepare or not the feasibility to later generate an Authorizing, Approving or Denial Administrative Ruling of the request in question, in accordance with what is contemplated in Decree No. 276 and in the Management Plans and Use Regulations for each National Park and in the case of recreation parks according to their current Decree 2817 of 1998.

The considerations include projects of occupation of the territory, affectation of resources with their respective evaluation of the Environmental Impact Studies, home repair, research, recreational events, sports,

religious events, maintenance of telecommunications, filming and photographic activities.

With the online modality, at the address <http://siapap.minec.gob.ve/>, the interested parties will be able to monitor the status of the requests and will know earlier if the activity proceeds or not.

In the process of digitalizing and placing the procedures online, the staff of the General Directorate of the Office of Information and Communication Technologies of the Minec, IT technicians of the Directorate of National Parks and Recreation Parks of Inparques, servers of the Directorate of the Inparques Office, as well as the regional directorates and their teams.

Venezuela advances in a concrete way in the fulfillment of the 5th. Historical Objective of the Homeland Plan

With the presence of the People's Power Minister for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, and the representative of the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) in Venezuela, Alexis Bonte, the project "Conservation and Sustainable Use of the Biological Diversity in the Caroní River Basin of Bolívar State".

The project began at the end of 2019 and meant the preparation of two instruments: the identification (PIF) and the Project Document (ProDoc).

This year, once the ideas were consolidated, the project was taken to the FAO, to intercede in the presentation before the Global Environment Facility (GEF, for its acronym in English). It is expected to have a draft of the project by mid-March 2023 and completion in June.

The project covers 8.6% of the national territory, more than 7,900,962 hectares, which represents 83% of the basin that guarantees 95% of hydroelectric energy.

Also present at the event were the Vice President of the Venezuelan Corporation of Guayana (CVG), the Political Secretary of the Bolivarian entity, Noel Amador, and spokespersons for various State institutions.

Minister Lorca explained that this initiative is part of "the effort of our President Nicolás Maduro to advance concretely in the fulfillment of the 5th. Objective of the Homeland Plan and the construction of Ecosocialism as a Venezuelan alternative to the Climate Crisis".

Among the organizations, the Ministry of Water Attention (MinAguas), Indigenous Peoples, the National Institute of Meteorology and Hydrology (Inameh), the Ministry of Electric Power (Mippee), the National Electric Corporation (Corpoelec) and several general directorates of the Minec (Ecosystem Management and Conservation Policies, Climate Change, Integration and International Affairs Office, Forest Heritage).

New way of doing tourism contemplates environmental education and sustainability

In order to demonstrate the best of the country in the various tourist areas, the International Tourism Fair Venezuela (Fitven) was inaugurated in the state of Anzoátegui.

During the opening, the Minister of Popular Power for Tourism, Alí Padrón, was present, who began the symposiums, with a conversation about the importance of tourism in all aspects, rural, urban, cultural and mountain, among others.

He expressed that it is necessary to take advantage of the natural diversity that Venezuela has, in addition to the stewardship and governance, management of destinations and products, training, training and awareness.

He indicated that the symposiums demonstrate the new way of doing tourism, which includes sustainability, environmental education, as well as the development of projects with private and public companies together with the National Government.

Representing the National Institute of Parks (Inparques), was the Director of Training of the National Headquarters, Magaly Alviar, with an interesting presentation on the National Park System: Venezuelan Ecotourism Potential.

Alviar developed the importance of Ecotourism

within the areas protected by Inparques, because it promotes educational, scientific, sports and artistic activities that contribute to the creation of environmental awareness.

He also explained the importance of Inparques for the preservation of the environment in Venezuela and fundamental for tourism, since it generates new ways in the people-nature relationship, he also outlined to those present the origin of the institute, its mission and objective.

Regarding sustainable tourism, Alviar pointed out that Inparques fully takes into account the current and future economic, social and environmental impacts, in response to the needs of visitors, the industry, the environment and the host communities.

"Ecotourism guarantees environmental education as a first, which includes environmental interpretation trails, hiking, mountaineering, adventure tourism, camping and bivouac, better known as outdoor camping, without the use of a tent", said Alviar.

"This new way of carrying out and applying ecotourism is a joint effort between the Minister of Tourism, Alí Padrón, and the Minister of Ecosocialism and President of Inparques Josué Lorca, in the search for the preservation of the environment", added Alviar.

My Park Recycles

Installed 100 benches in the Generalissimo Francisco de Miranda made with recycled material

As a result of the collection of material in the various parks and subsequent processing, the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec) began the installation of 100 benches in the Generalísimo Francisco de Miranda Recreational Park, east of Greater Caracas, made with recycled plastic material.

The action is the result of the "My park recycles" program, launched by Minec this year, which contemplates the collection of waste through containers for the classification of plastic, glass and paper, duly identified by colors, placed at the entrances and strategic park sites.

In this sense, the benches that are placed are the product of a high-density plastic, excellent quality, resistant, durable and with a good finish, in a demonstration to the population, of the benefits and new objects that can be obtained based on the use of garbage, in order to change from a linear economy to a circular one.

In quarantine

Joint action with the PNB recovers a Cunaguaro specimen

Officials of the Bolivarian National Police (PNB), who were conducting a surveillance round in the El Limón neighborhood on the old Caracas-La Guaira highway, managed to recover a specimen of a cunaguaro, which was abandoned by some subjects who fled when they saw the cash commission.

The animal was transferred to the police headquarters for hydration, feeding and the Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, was immediately contacted, who ordered the dispatch of a specialized delegation to the place.

On site was the prominent veterinarian at the Caricuao Zoological Park, Adrián Carreño, who took

all precautionary measures for the handling of the cunaguaro and its mobilization to the zoo, where the specimen will be subjected to more extensive examinations and placed in quarantine.

The tour was carried out in the company of representatives of the Government of Zulia, with the purpose of developing a work route for the recovery and reopening of the place, which has kept its doors closed for 4 years.

In order to maintain a harmonious relationship with the environment and ensure its care, the 1st Caricuao Ecological and Conscious Congress was held at the E.T.R. "Francisco Fajardo", from the populous parish in the southwest of Caracas.

The inhabitants of the parish attended the meeting to share useful information about caring for the environment, inside and outside their community.

The event was attended by the Ministries of Popular Power for Urban Agriculture (Minppau) and Ecosocialism (Minec), representatives of the Mayor's Office of Caracas and the Karicuao Caribe

Agroecological School.

In this regard, the director of the Karicuao Caribe Agroecological School, Johan de Sousa, noted that with this first Ecological Congress "we are working on a proposal addressed to the Community Councils and Social Movements organized in the parish, for a program for the use and exchange of plastic".

He explained that they are working on three fundamental lines: the formation of Councils of Sectoral Workers to provide services to the community; the economic environmental issue with the reduction of waste in dumps and landfills; and the use of materials from garbage.
