As part of the 1 x 10 of Good Government, the Sectorial Vice-Presidency of Public Works and Services, developed a working day in the state of Trujillo, in what constituted the territorial entity number 20 addressed, in which the needs of the people are met.

The meeting was chaired by the Vice President and also Minister of Popular Power for Electric Energy, G/J Néstor Reverol, accompanied by the head of Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca; Transportation, Ramón Velásquez Araguayán; Attention of the Waters, G/D. Rodolfo Marcos Torres; Public Works, G/D Raúl Paredes and the authorities of the Anonymous Telephone Company of Venezuela (Cantv), and PDVSA Gas Comunal.

Minister Lorca received 120 complaints and assumed the commitment to evaluate a space for the placement of a solid waste transfer station by the year 2023.

Additionally, Minister Lorca inspected the landfill closed 8 years ago in the Pampanito municipality, Palo Negro sector, in the company of the mayor Leonel Vielma and the president of the Maintenance, Cleaning and Ornament Company (EMAO), José Reyes.

Also, it was decided to install 10 recycling schools with awareness spaces and the formation of 193 Recycling and Cleaning Technical Tables (Metras).

The Vice Presidency achieved the start-up of the Monay Generation Plant in the region with a contribution of 15 Megawatts (MW) to the National Electric System (SEN).

In the same way, progress was made in the installation of a thousand luminaires within the Comprehensive Lighting Plan for Express Roads and the inclusion of Trujillo as a prioritized entity in the National Strategic Plan for the Attention of Roads and Bridges.

Likewise, the Las Acacias, Betijoque, Carvajal and Valera pumping systems were activated, with an impact on 300,000 inhabitants.

The start of the construction of the La Caracola road variant, main route, trunk 007 of the Valera-Boconó section, as well as the rehabilitation of the Troncal T001, Cheregüe sector of the Bolívar municipality and El Corozo of the Miranda jurisdiction, was resolved.

In addition, 4,850 voice, data, internet and television services were delivered.

Responsible use of the tourist attraction

Bolivarian Government denies ecocide in the Mukumbarí Cable Car System

The governor of the state of Mérida, Jehyson Guzman, and the ministers of Tourism, Alí Padrón, and Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, inspected the Mukumbarí Cable Car System, to deny rumors about a possible ecocide in the area.

On the site, a meeting was held with all the actors involved to establish work actions that strengthen the responsible use of the tourist attraction, without violating the Sierra Nevada National Park.

“For the tranquility of the people of Merida, we went to the Mukumbarí Cable Car System and made sure that there is no ecocide in our National Park. In addition, we verify the progress of the construction of a new

viewpoint that will guarantee a safer visit for all tourists”, explained Minister Lorca.

He also indicated that the new stop is located inside the Loma Redonda station and was created because in previous years there were several accidents with tourists who slipped when approaching to contemplate the view of the Bolívar peak.

For his part, the Minister of Tourism, Alí Padrón, reported that this stage of the cable car will be reactivated on December 9, while Governor Jehyson Guzmán explained that during the next few days the deteriorated roof sheets will be installed, The walls will be painted and reinforcement walls will be built in external areas.



New viewpoint guarantees safety

It contributes 80% of the water consumed by the city of Boconó

One hectare of the Quebrada Segovia basin in Trujillo has been reforested

As part of the 2022-2023 National Reforestation Plan, the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec) reforested one hectare corresponding to the Segovia stream basin, which provides 80% of the water consumed by the city of Boconó, in Trujillo state.

In the place, 30 caote trees were placed, a species of rapid growth and colonization, for an area that is frequently affected by fire.

Likewise, the Minec commission traveled to the Laguna de Los Cedros community in Boconó, in the buffer zone of the Guaramacal National Park, with the aim of reviewing the experience of the community nursery promoted by the institution together with the National Experimental University of Los Western Plains Ezequiel Zamora (Unellez).

They also visited the Park Ranger post of the Guaramacal National Park, with the purpose of verifying the conditions of the nursery on

the site, which contributes to the National Reforestation Plan, with plants typical of the altitudinal floors of the area.

The People's Power Minister for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, together with the president of the Venezuela Bella Mission and the liaison of the United Socialist Party (Psuv) for Zulia, Jacqueline Faría, established some agreements to protect Lake Maracaibo.

The meeting, which took place in the office of the Ministry for Ecosocialism (Minec), located in the South Tower of El Silencio, in the center of the capital, reviewed various aspects, including the use of shrimp, crabs and protection of Lake Maracaibo.

"We talked about the requests for wood for the stilt

houses, something that the Minister immediately managed, so that these houses that were affected by the rains could be recovered", said Faría.

He also pointed out that the issue of climate change and how it affects the Lake was discussed, in addition to other plans for the year 2023.

"I appreciate the attention and plans of the Maracaibo Plain Hydraulic System Regional Company (Planimara), of the Institute for the Control and Conservation of the Lake Maracaibo Basin (ICLAM), of the Minec state office, all based on a performance in the Lake, one of the most important basins in the country", he concluded.

Las Delicias de Maracay Zoo receives the Orinoco manatee

The Orinoco manatee, a first-generation specimen that reproduces in captivity at the Bararida Zoological and Botanical Park in Lara state, was transferred to the Las Delicias Zoo in the city of Maracay.

These aquatic mammals (*Trichechus manatus*) are greyish in color, large in size and heavy. They grow to regularly reach three meters and weigh from 400 to 600 kilograms.

A manatee reaches maturity at approximately six months and during its growth is fed with fresh lettuce, chard, spinach, carrots and bananas. Each mature specimen consumes about 30 kg of food.

Orinoco was born on April 2, 2018, as part of the reproduction program of the species that is carried out in Bararida and will now be on display at Las Delicias, a center that is undergoing rehabilitation and is about to reopen.

Seeds and polyethylene bags were delivered

To strengthen the "One student, one tree" program, carried out by the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), seeds and polyethylene bags were delivered to directors of educational institutions in seven parishes in the capital.

The event, which took place at the "Andrés Bello" Educational Complex, was chaired by the head of Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, accompanied by the Vice Minister of Environmental Management Services of the Minec, Hernán Toro, and the Minister of Education Yelitze Santaella.

The favored parishes were: El Recreo with 7 circuits that include 68 schools, San Agustín 3 circuits and 19 centers; San José 4 circuits and 23 centers; Altigracia 4 circuits and 31 centers; Cathedral 3 circuits and 16 centers; San Juan 5 circuits and 59 centers, and Santa Teresa 3 circuits and 22 centers.

With the assignment of the kits, the Minec hopes to impact a total of 60,155 students, who are part of the enrollment of the aforementioned educational centers, the awareness of the student body is achieved regarding the importance of the action of planting and monitoring the growth of plants, as a contribution to mitigation and adaptation to the climate crisis.

In this regard, Minister Lorca explained that "this program that we bring is a dream that emerged at

the end of February, beginning of March. We are going to turn 'A student, a tree' into something that will last many years and that every year our girls and boys plant and produce a tree," she reiterated.

He pointed out that they want "this time we do a pedagogical exercise from the school to the family, so that a tree can be produced, taken to the school and then placed in an affected area".

"Right now 8,000,000 million trees are going to be produced throughout the country. Each school must have its kit with the number of seeds per school student so that between March and April the plants reach a height between 30 and 40 centimeters, and we have the figure that I announced", he assured.

He affirmed that the deliveries are well advanced because "last week ten parishes had the kits, yesterday three more were given and today seven to complete 22 of 23 parishes in Caracas".

For her part, Minister Santaella asserted that "this is the most beautiful program because we are sowing life: 'A tree, a student' is life for the future".

"It is life for the new generations, for their children and grandchildren. It is a flagship program, which is why I want to insist a lot on it and its continuity", Santaella stated.

Against the Indiscriminate Use of Agrochemicals

Documentary projected "The Seed of Evil: Bayer and Monsanto"

In this regard, the director of Dissemination of the General Directorate of Training of the Minec, David Álvarez, indicated that the film is in the context of the "World Day Against the Indiscriminate Use of Agrochemicals."

"It deals with the actions of the transnationals Bayer and Monsanto for the control of seeds and food, in addition to the imposition of transgenic, genetically modified seeds", he said.
