Reciven will process recyclable solid waste in Caracas



At the beginning, 150 tons of solid waste will be reclassified and in three months it is expected to increase to 2,500 tons

s part of the Caracas Plan "The new face of conscience", the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), in alliance with the Mayor's Office of Caracas, inaugurated the Venezuela Recycling plant (Reciven).

The structure has the purpose of reducing the solid waste produced and spread in the Capital city, as an alternative to the work carried out so far by the Technical Recycling and Cleaning Tables (Metras).

The mayoress of Caracas, A/J Carmen Meléndez, and the head of Minec, Josué Lorca, were at the start of Reciven's operations in the Caricuao ecological parish, where 10 operational vehicles were delivered, repaired by the company Sermac de the Mayor's Office

and a new one, at the disposal of the city of Caracas, for the development and maintenance of the streets, in search of an ecosocialist capital territory.

Minister Lorca detailed the importance of raising awareness among the people, from the family, children and parents to grandparents, around the use of materials and solid waste, such as paper, cardboard, glass and plastic, among others.

"This plant adds to the work of collecting and reducing solid waste in the capital, starting with 150 tons and with the goal that in 3 months 2,500 tons of garbage will be reclassified to be reused in other products," he explained.

Lorca also highlighted the existence of different initiatives in organized communities in

which an exchange of collected usable materials is carried out, for community services or solutions, such as elevator repair, gardening and white water systems, among others.

These types of projects have been established throughout the national territory, with the example of the Recycling School inaugurated in Barcelona, promoted and managed by the local People's Power, in alliance with the Government of Anzoátegui, headed by Luis José Marcano, and the Minec, in what constitutes a technological, industrial and eco-socialist plan, which guarantees the collection, use and reduction of solid waste, to achieve a cleaner and greener country.

he Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, participated in the installation of the 2023 National Youth Congress, as a member of the Youth Staff.

The initiative is promoted by the President of the Republic, Nicolás Maduro Moros, for the creation of the Great Venezuelan Youth Mission.

The meeting was also attended by the Youth Staff, the PSUV National Youth Directorate, the National Directorate of the Venezuelan Federation of Secondary Education Students (Fveem), the Venezuelan Federation of University Students (FVEU), delegates territorial and sectorial youth, Vice President Mervin Maldonado, Vice President Gabriela Jiménez and the Minister of Education, Yelitze Santaella.

The purpose of the meeting is to hold discussions on various proposals regarding education, culture, economy, theater, entrepreneurship, sports, and housing, in an effort to guarantee improvements in life, development, and opportunities for Venezuelan youth.

Two Metras were installed

45 Mangrove Guardians sworn in in Higuerote



Socialist Commune Carenero and providers of Tourist Services of Green Beach join recycling

n the Lagoon The Queen in the Brión de Higuerote municipality, Miranda state, a group of Guardians of the Mangrove was sworn in and two Technical Recycling and Cleaning Tables (Metras) were installed.

In the act, 45 people were sworn in as Guardians of the Mangrove, in order that their actions guarantee the protection of the areas and ecosystems of the region, while they are expected to bring knowledge about the conservation and recovery of the mangroves and wetlands of Higuerote.

The main sources of protein that guarantee the survival of the population come from the mangroves, and therefore the importance of teaching and motivating the population in the conservation and recovery of these spaces.

The Restoration Plan is based on the National Program of President Nicolás Maduro Moros, which refers to the Fifth Objective of the Homeland Plan 2019-2025: "Contribute to the preservation of life on the planet and the salvation of the human species".

For her part, the Head of Government of the Carenero Socialist Commune, Heydi Hernández, indicated that "we have to emphasize that both the Metras and the care of the environment, we must take it to the houses, because we are the ones who are going to raise these children who already have a brigade".

"They are sworn in as the Metra Ecosocialista Brigade, which will work within the Community Councils", he said.

I add that "the idea is to extend it to the entire Miranda state, because it is there where embraced, as President Hugo Chávez taught us, the organized people are the ones who lead, while the government and the authorities are there to guide us and we do it accordingly." The best way".

Meanwhile, the director of the Office of the Mayor of the Brión Municipality, Víctor Castellano, was present at the swearing in of the Metras and the Guardians of the Mangrove.

"On behalf of the mayor, we want to express our support for these programs, so that we all support the conservation of our beaches, the wetlands, a legacy left to us by our commander Hugo Chávez and continued by President Nicolás Maduro Moros, and it is in the constitution", he claimed.

This activity was carried out to establish recycling, in the Socialist Commune Carenero and Playa Valle Seco Tourist Service Providers in Higuerote, through the recovery of reusable waste, which can be generated in the axis of Valle Seco Carenero and allow the sanitation of the Lagoon The Queen ecosystem.

First international workshop on vulnerability and adaptation to the climate crisis held

ith the purpose of possible seeking solutions to by ravages caused the climate crisis in the country, first international workshop called: "Extremes, vulnerability and adaptation to climate change: towards the biennial transparency report (NDC-BTR)" was held. sponsored by the Ministry of Popular Power for Science and Technology and Institute Venezuelan Scientific Research (IVIC).

The information was provided by the head of the recently created IVIC Global Environmental Crisis Center, Carlos Méndez, who pointed out that the activity has allowed for an exchange of knowledge and experiences, with international and national experts, on the subject of the climate crisis. and its effects.

Representatives of the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism participated, which carries out the issue throughout the national

territory of the climate crisis and the National Institute of Meteorology and Hydrology (Inamec) which is in charge of monitoring climate throughout the country.

The climate expert explained "we are looking for and creating the right conditions to start a conversation between the entities, in charge of designing public and scientific policies, which through knowledge, make these public policies have a greater impact."

South America's largest chelonians

More than 950 thousand Arrau turtles released through the National Conservation Program of 964.621

individuals of Tortuga Arrau, bred in breeding centers, have been released the National Conservation Program for the species.

Every March 19, the National Day of the Arrau Turtle is commemorated in Venezuela, an occasion that calls for the preservation of the species that is in danger of extinction.

The Arrau is one of the largest turtles in South America, also known as the Orinoco turtle. It inhabits the rivers and lagoons of the Amazon and Orinoco river basins.

They are characterized by being of variable sizes, mainly herbivorous, they are swimmers par excellence. During the time of rise in the level of the rivers. it enters the areas of flooded forest. In Venezuela, the greatest abundance of this species is found in the Middle Orinoco.

is a freshwater reptile, the largest in the American continent. Its carapace grayish-brown and may have a cream-colored rim in juveniles.

It has a gray head with cream-colored spots on the tip of the snout and on each side and top of the head. Females can reach a maximum length of 89 cm and 60 kilos in weight. Males can reach a length of 55 cm and about 5 kilos.

790.989 turtles, incorporated into their habitat between 1999 and 2022.

The distribution of the tortoise is not exclusive to Venezuela, as it has been registered in Colombia, Guyana, Brazil, Ecuador, Bolivia and Peru.
