Environmental authorities advance towards the implementation of the Paris Agreement at COP28



COP28 will be held in the United Arab Emirates this 2023

The People's Power Minister for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, discussed with world environmental representatives the route towards the implementation of the Paris agreement at COP28. "We continue to build an Ecosocialist Homeland," he said.

The information was offered by Minister Lorca, through a message posted on his account on the Instagram social network, during his participation in the Ministerial Conference on Climate

in Copenhagen, Denmark. Among the most outstanding topics in the meeting, which lasted for two days, were adaptation, mitigation, climate financing and the loss and damage fund.

"We are discussing together with the environmental authorities of the world the route towards the implementation of the Paris Agreement at COP28 to be held in the United Arab Emirates this 2023," detailed one of the messages.

In addition, ministerial authorities discussed the status

of implementation, including international, regional and national experiences, including through partnerships with the private sector and other relevant stakeholders.

The Venezuelan delegation headed by the head of the Ecosocialism portfolio strengthens the commitment of the Bolivarian Government and adds efforts to advance in the fight against the Climate Crisis.

Venezuela celebrates World Climate Day with the commitment to protect and care for it

The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela celebrated "World Climate Day" this Sunday by ratifying the commitment to change the system to preserve it.

This day was established since 1950 from the United Nations

Convention (UN) and the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) and is commemorated by more than 180 countries.

The date exposes a topic of interest to humanity, by detailing the importance of the climate and seeking to raise awareness

among people about what actions are positive to protect and care for the environment.

As part of the house-to-house conferences called: "The climate crisis affects us all," the fourth national deployment from Caracas took place this weekend, specifically in the Barrio Nazareno, located in the Estanque de Propatria sector, as well as in the Simón Rodríguez urban planning of Ciudad Tiuna, to learn about the perception people have about climate change, its causes and effects.

The objective of these operations is to raise awareness among the population about the risk factors that affect the climate crisis, in the same way, to involve the communities in the formation and consolidation of Brigades against Climate Change and to ensure that young people implement in their lives daily good environmental and ecological practices.

In Propatria, three sectors were addressed: Primera Escalera, Calle Mora and Callejón Continente, in which families were sensitized and informed about the climate crisis and labels "Here we fight climate

change" were placed in the houses that were visited.

The People's Power Minister for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, commented that "we propose in a very simple way, that our boys, team of Park Rangers, Forest Firefighters and the rest of the Minec Ecosocialist Management Team, go house to house raising awareness the inhabitants of this community, to explain what is happening nationally and globally".

"We want work commitments to improve the living of this community in environmental matters, that this team go with a message against the climate crisis, of how we can work hand in hand with the community, to face this problem together," he said.

Along with the head of the Minec, the National Director of the Brigades against Climate Change (BCCC), Jean Román, the director of the Reforestation Plan Monitoring Room and the House to House Program, Emiselys Duarte, the director of the Ecosocialist Territorial Unit (UTEC) Capital District, Marlín Jiménez, the head of

the Forest Fire Department, General Germán Gutiérrez, the head of the Civil Park Ranger Corps, Pablo Lira, the National Director of Ecosocialist Training of the National Institute of Parks (Inparques), Magaly Alviar, in addition to members of the Forest Firefighters, Park Rangers and Brigade members against Climate Change.

In this regard, the head of the Hugo Chávez Battle Unit (Ubch) of the E.B. Monsignor Jesús María Pellín, Marisol Palacios, indicated that "we were waiting for this house-to-house campaign so that the community in the sector is more aware of what we are going through: the climate change crisis."

During the weekend, awareness days were held in the 24 entities of the country, carrying the environmental, prevention and information message on the climate crisis that affects planet earth.

In compliance with the Law

Installed Unified Command against Forest Fires in Cojedes and Delta Amacuro

With the purpose of detecting, preventing, combating and restoring natural areas affected by fire, the Unified Command against Forest Fires was activated in the states of Cojedes and Delta Amacuro.

The Command in the state of Cojedes, will be made up of 345 officials and will be the operational body that carries out awareness-raising actions regarding the prevention, pre-suppression, suppression and recovery of areas affected by forest fires in the state.

One of the main objectives is to disseminate among the population, mainly those dedicated to agricultural activities, the obligation they have to offer sufficient protection to the natural resources located within their properties, to comply with articles numbers 78 and 79 of the Forest Law.

In the same way, the command develops informative campaigns, aimed at raising awareness among citizens in relation to the protection and conservation of natural resources and fire control.

This command is made up of the Comprehensive Defense Zone of each entity, the Fire Department, Civil Protection (PC), Bolivarian National Guard (GNB), 911 Emergencies, Brigades against Forest Fires, Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec) and its attached entities, government of each state and the Bolivarian National Guard. These members carry out invaluable work for the safety and protection of natural spaces and urban areas with wooded areas.

The installation of the command in the state of Cojedes was led by the commander of the ZODI34, G/D Miguel Cuadros, the director of the Ecosocialist Territorial Unit (UTEC) Cojedes of

the Minec, Rafael Pérez Siso, the governor of the entity, Alberto Galíndez, and other civil and military authorities.

In this regard, G/D Miguel Cuadros highlighted that this is the second act that has been carried out in the country and "Cojedes continues to be an imposing state and at the forefront."

"345 officials are deployed for this operation, ready all the motorcycles of the Bolivarian National Armed Forces, citizen security agencies, fire protection vehicles, firefighter vehicles and especially the super tankers of the People's Guard, which each have a capacity of 35,000 liters," he said.

For his part, the director of UTEC Cojedes, Rafael Pérez Siso, affirmed that the Minec will be aware and will monitor and control, "fighting instantly the incidents that arise in this matter."

Seeds collected at Los Chorros Recreational Park for World Water Day

A day of collecting seeds in the Los Chorros Recreational Park, allowed the message of education, awareness and sensitization to be conveyed to the Brigadistas against Climate Change and to the members of the School Ecological Brigades of the Luis Beltrán Pietero Figueroa National Educational Unit of Caracas.

The brigade members received information about the importance of seeds and the meaning of planting a tree as a generator of life and a producer of water.

Likewise, they learned about the relevance of preserving water and the planet, in defense of biodiversity, which complies with the Fifth Historical Objective of the Plan de la Patria 2019-2025, which indicates the "Preservation of life on the planet and the salvation of the human species", as elements that contribute to the mitigation and adaptation to climate change.

The Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (MINEC), in line with the guidelines of the National Government, continues the work of collecting seeds, concentrating on the productivity of forest, ornamental and medicinal seedlings, which will later be replanted in the settlements arranged for forest reforestation and agroforestry throughout Venezuela.

During the operation, the director of the Monitoring Room of the National Reforestation Plan, Emiselys Duarte, was present, who highlighted the attention and efforts of the Minister for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, with the National Reforestation Plan (PNR) 2022-2023.

The PNR includes five programs among its action schemes: One student, one tree, Conserving, Sowing Life, Urbanism and Family Agroforestry, with the aim of preserving the environment and protecting water resources.

To date, more than 8 million plants have been established and work has been done in 20,000 entities organized between Communes, social movements, educational organizations and urban planning, among others, in which at least 3 million people have been served.

The attendees were insisted that the placement of trees guarantees oxygen and water for

current and future generations.

In the meeting, the sowing cycle was presented, contemplated in the program "A student a tree", in which each of the students They will be able to monitor the growth process of a plant from their homes, to later establish it, as part of the actions promoted by the PNR, in search of the recovery and preservation of the environments and water zones of the country.

The Coastal Zones Committee held an exhibition meeting before authorities of the Sucre Ecosocialist Territorial Unit (UTEC) of the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (MINEC), and the government of the entity, to evaluate the progress of the invasive coral "*Unomia Stolonifera*", in the Mochima National Park.

The meeting was attended by the director of the UTEC in the region, Daniel Franco, the head of the Office of the Governor, Onny Parra, staff from the Institute for Advanced Studies (IDEA), the Socialist Tourism

Corporation of the Sucre state (Corsotur), the Ministry of Science and Technology (Mincyt), the Oceanographic Institute of Venezuela, and the Fundación Conciencia Ecosocial.

The IDEA Invasive Species coordinator, Sinatra Salazar, made a presentation to demonstrate the progress of the project for the development and evaluation of a biocontrol of the *Unomia Stolonifera* species.

Likewise, it was announced that the Coastal Zones Committee continues with the execution of awareness actions for the inhabitants of Mochima Bay

and Santa Fe Bay, a place that is invaded by coral.

It was highlighted that from the Sucre State Educational Zone (ZEES), there have been talks, forums in the schools of the Mochima population, in addition to giving talks to local workers and fishermen, in order to curb the reach of coral and its spread to other areas.

There is a presence of the invasive coral in the coastal region of the Sucre, Anzoátegui and Falcón states, which are attended with programs for their detention.

Minec Anzoategui

Egidsa recycling plant inspected to guide the Renma process

As part of the Inspection Plan carried out by the Ministry of Popular Power for Ecosocialism (MINEC), a visit was made to the Egidsa Recycling Plant, located in the Mesones sector of the Simón Bolívar municipality, in Anzoátegui state.

During the visit, the production process in the recovery of plastic materials was evaluated, with the purpose of providing guidance to the company in the National Registry of Non-Hazardous Waste and Waste Management (Renma), and

guaranteeing the proper handling of paper, cardboard, glass, plastic and others.

The measure is in line with the line of action committed to strengthening the systems for the collection, transportation, transfer, treatment, and final disposal of solid waste, through the recovery, rehabilitation, and repowering of the vehicle fleet, as well as the sanitation of landfills, and landfills in the national territory.

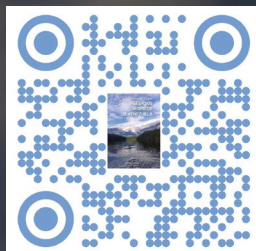
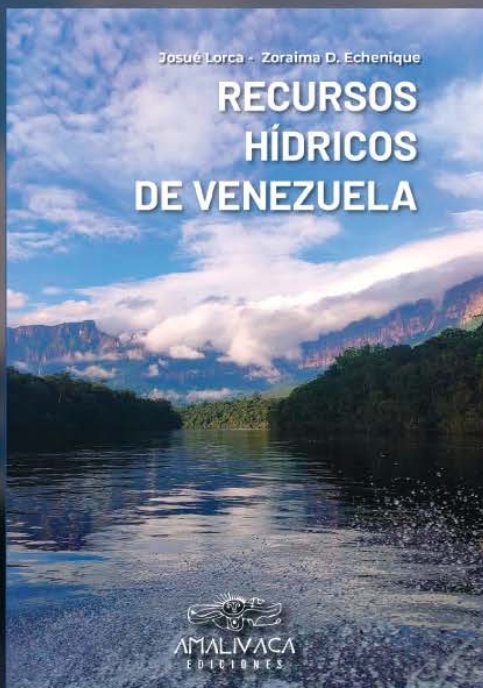
These actions correspond to the guidelines of President Nicolás Maduro, executed by Minister

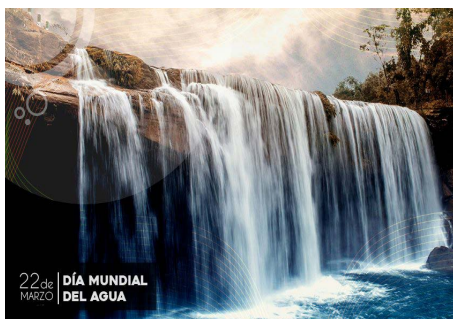
