With the objective of preserving Mother Earth, the Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, informed that from October 9 to 16, the II National Congress of Researchers on the Climate Crisis will be held in the states of Mérida, Falcón and the Capital District.

The head of the Minec indicated that this is an academic meeting with 10 thematic areas of research and more than 195 thematic axes, which will be developed through classroom and distance methodology, so he made a call to researchers, organized Popular Power, environmental community, social movements and any organization or person who contributes to the ecological issue, to register for this event, whose process began this September 2 and will be extended until the 22nd.

Lorca explained that the Congress will have a jury whose mission will be to evaluate the different projects to be financed.

"It will be 7 days of intense debates to discuss the challenges and explore the threats and risks arising from the Climate Crisis," he said.

He emphasized that this second edition is proposed after the successful experience of the first National Congress of researchers on the Climate Crisis, held in La Casona Cultural "Aguiles Nazoa" in May 2022, which on that occasion had the participation of more than 3,500 people online and about 1,500 people in person.

He recalled that from that first National Congress, the President of the Republic, Nicolás Maduro, authorized the creation of the Revolving Fund against the Climate Crisis, which has so far financed 41 research, adaptation and monitoring projects in more than 11 states of the country.

Effective work of the Presidential Commission

Environmental Liabilities Recovery Plan begins in Maracaibo Lake

The Presidential Commission for the Rescue, Conservation and Sustainable Development of Maracaibo Lake, headed by G/J Néstor Reverol, began the Plan for the Recovery of Environmental Liabilities in this important lake area.

The Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, indicated that this is a project of "sanitation" of all the environmental liabilities of the country's ports, which starts in this lake and will cover the whole territory. He assured that the scrap removed will be sent to the steel mills to be transformed into inputs for construction and "into raw material for development".

For his part, the Minister of Transportation, Ramón Velásquez Araguayán, explained that the Plan for the Recovery of Environmental Liabilities in Lake Maracaibo "is an extraordinary task to refloat all these vessels to return to Lake Maracaibo the strength and beauty that the people of Zulia demand".

The operation will be under the supervision of the Corporación Ecosocialista Ezequiel Zamora, S.A. (CORPOEZ), which is responsible for the processes for which it has specialized machinery and professional personnel in the handling of this type of material.

Inspection of the rehabilitation process of ICLAM's Bergantín

This week, the Presidential Commission for the Rescue, Conservation and Sustainable Development of Lake Maracaibo, visited the facilities of Diques y Astilleros Nacionales C.A. (Dianca) Occidente, to inspect the progress of the rehabilitation works of the Bergantín ship of the Instituto de Conservación del Lago de Maracaibo (Iclam).

In this respect, the manager of Dianca Occidente, Joselin Jiménez, indicated that the vessel arrived at the company on August 19 and has been dismantled 80%.

Bergantín is an aluminum vessel of 22 meters in length and 6.50 meters in beam, which will have

45% of its case replaced and will have the laboratory, captain's and engine room, and engine generators replaced with new ones.

Also as part of the work of this Commission, the Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, inspected the rehabilitation works of the Institute for the Conservation of Lake Maracaibo (Iclam).

In this respect, the Minister of Ecosocialism indicated that "the Iclam will be the reference center for the rebirth of our lake", since this space has a battery of laboratories that will allow the physical and chemical characterization of all the conditions of the lake.

The refurbishment includes, in addition to the laboratories, the library, auditorium, administrative and public service areas.

"A total of 400 supplies will be provided, including LED lights, reagent tanks and air conditioners, among others," explained Lorca.

The Minister of People's Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, guaranteed that the institution's planners and landscapers, who have experience in the development of natural areas, will be at the service of the work process of the Ana María Campos Monumental Park in the state of Zulia.

During an inspection to the work area where he was invited by the president of the Venezuela Bella Mission, Jacqueline Faría, in charge of the development of the monumental park, Lorca assured that the Minec has a team of professionals, of landscapers who are at the disposal for the construction and accompaniment of this project.

"This is a great blank sheet on which one deposits dreams, hopes, experiences, from the machinists to those who make their contribution by putting a

plant or suggesting to place a gallery of multicolored flowers".

He added that it is always important to have a clear concept of what one wants, based on his experience in the recovery of national parks and recreation.

He said that it is necessary "that the park is born with a soul, with a sense and a projection because that is what will allow its existence and permanence".

Lorca gave as an example the Parque Recreacional Generalísimo Francisco de Miranda, in Caracas, whose area they wanted to turn into residential blocks and the citizens, architects and landscapers were the first to oppose.

"That struggle was transformed into what we can now say is the main recreational park in Venezuela, a national heritage," he said.

He said that "the majesty of the Generalísimo Francisco de Miranda is representative of all the landscape environments of Venezuela".

He also recalled that the Presidential Commission is advancing in the recovery of the Zulia Metropolitan Zoo, which has three times the area of the Ana María Campos Monumental Park.

"Equivalent to 90 hectares, which has developed areas with quite large trees, some lagoons, five wells, of which three in the process of recovery".

However, he explained that the place has to undergo a structural redesign because it is not going to fulfill the same services as it did a few years ago. "It will be a zoo and will be adapted to recreational spaces", he concluded.

Biodiversity protection

Zulia Metropolitan Zoo to have a Wildlife Rescue Center



Zulia Metropolitan Zoo is recovering to become a great wildlife rescue center

The Presidential Commission for the Rescue, Conservation and Sustainable Development of Lake Maracaibo is making progress in the integral recovery of the Metropolitan Zoo of the state of Zulia, with the objective of providing the people of Zulia with a space for recreation and healthy leisure.

After the intervention announced by the National Government, heavy machinery and cleaning crews approached the green areas of the zoo to weed the grounds, apply phytosanitary treatment to all the trees and beautify the areas where visitors will be able to spend the night and visualize the wildlife species that will be in the place.

Recently, the Minister of Popular Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, informed that together with the Ministry of Fishing, the Council

of Fisherwomen, Fishermen and Aquaculture (Conppa), Petróleos de Venezuela Sociedad Anónima (Pdvs) and regional institutions, fauna is being rescued in some areas of Lake Maracaibo where there are contaminating processes.

To shelter these species, the Institute for the Conservation of Lake Maracaibo (Iclam) and PDVSA, installed the first fauna rescue center with the environmentalist movements.

He informed that, likewise, the reconditioning works of the zoo are accentuated on weekends, due to the fact that animals in vulnerable situations will be protected there.

"The Zulia Metropolitan Zoo is being recovered in the first instance to make this great center for the rescue of fauna, of all this great biodiversity. Let's remember that Zulia is one of the

most megadiverse states we have in the country. The zoo will also be for recreation and enjoyment, which will be added, as instructed by our President, to the Ana María Campos Monumental Park, as another space recovered for the good living of all Zulians," he said.

Likewise, the head of the Minec emphasized that the zoo will have a new modality that has a greater focus on the recreation and leisure of the users. In addition to the protection and conservation of the flora and fauna present.

The second phase will be the installation of security with the recovery of the security booth, electricity and the installation of the water network. The plan includes the Governor's Office of Zulia and businessmen of the region who want to participate in the recovery of the Zoo.

In Zulia

Awareness raising and reforestation took place along the coastline of the Francisco de Miranda municipality

A public awareness and planting day was held on the coastline of Plaza Bolívar, in the municipality of San Francisco, where at least 100 trees native to the area, such as almendrón and clemón, were

planted in areas intervened with sanitation and solid waste collection operations.

During the activity, the participating authorities reiterated the call to the community in

general to join these activities on a voluntary basis.

The Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism and members of the Sotalia Project agreed that Venezuela and Colombia will soon carry out a binational expedition in the Casiquiare River, in the state of Amazonas.

The head of the Minec assured that this project is framed within the nine lines of action for the defense and protection of the Amazon,

in order to collect scientific data on the species *Inia geoffrensis* (Tonina), which is protected and threatened.

He added that the project aims to guarantee the permanence of this species, in addition to helping the local population and promoting the development of tourism in the area.

"In this expedition, data will be taken such as the number of the

population and the state of health of the dolphins, which in turn will give us feedback on the state of the ecosystem where they live", he explained.

He added that the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism continues working to guarantee the care and preservation of the autochthonous species.

PNB released 337 birds retained in clandestine farm

A total of 337 exotic birds were released by officers of the National Bolivarian Police Corps (CPNB), after detecting that they were in a clandestine zoo.

The information was posted on the Instagram site of the Directorate of Strategic and Tactical Actions of the referred citizen security corps, where they disseminated a video of the procedure executed on Highway 13, Santos Luzardo, Union parish, Iribarren municipality, Barquisimeto, Lara state.

The rescued birds were taken into custody and released at

the Bararida botanical and zoological park, located in the capital city of Lara.

During the procedure, two individuals were arrested and will be prosecuted for allegedly committing the crime of irregular possession of wildlife specimens in captivity.

On August 25, the head of the Public Prosecutor's Office, Tarek William Saab, announced that his office appointed the 88th National Prosecutor's Office with competence in Environmental Defense and Environmental Crime, in order to investigate a complaint related to an alleged

smuggling of wildlife.
