Sixth goal proposed by President Nicolás Maduro is ecological

speech before the National (AN) to Assembly present his Annual Message to the Nation, the President of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Nicolás proposed seven obiectives. which he called Seven Transformations (7T), whose bases have already been cemented by the 3R.Nets, in order to advance in the development of the country towards a new model of well-being.

Objective number six or 6T, is related to ecology, which is aimed at adding actions to combat the climate promoting awareness and protecting the people from environmental impact, as well as safeguarding Amazon and natural reserves from the voracity of capitalism.

"When Commander Chávez proposed the Fifth Historic Objective, we had not yet entered a climate emergency, in 2012", affirmed the National President.

He recalled the case of some fishermen in the State of La Guaira who "went out to fish for tuna and in this season when the sea has to be cold, December, in January and February, the sea is warmer than ever (...) then they were able to fish, but what they were looking for, which was tuna, they did not get it", he highlighted.

Commission for the Rescue of Lake Maracaibo inspects Ana Maria Campos Monumental Park

He added that the referred plan is in the context of the Recycling and Cleaning Technical Tables (Metras) in the sector, which has more than 200 spokespersons.

"The project is for the future, life and the fulfillment of the 7Ts instructed by President Nicolás Maduro", he stated.

To improve garbage disposal services

Conditions of Santa Rita landfill in Zulia state reviewed

ith the purpose of improving garbage disposal services in the region, the Minister of Popular Power for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, together with the Mayor of the Santa Rita municipality of Zulia state, Alenis Guerrero, inspected an area that has been used as a landfill since 2006.

The inspection is part of the activities of the Master Plan for the Rescue, Conservation and Sustainable Development of Lake Maracaibo, carried out by the Bolivarian Government in the state

Guerrero, who is president of the Association of Mayors of the state of indicated that Zulia, the review of the site seeks to determine the possibility of establishing a commonwealth among municipalities for the deposit of solid waste.

In this respect, Minister accompanied Lorca, by the Vice-Minister of

Garbage Management of the Ministry of Ecosocialism, Guédez, pointed out that the conditions of the landfill and the capacity to receive solid waste from the municipalities of Cabimas, San Francisco and Santa Rita are being reviewed.

The joint action is in tune with the policies of optimizing and stabilizing the services indicated by President Nicolás Maduro, executed by the Sectorial Vice-Presidency of Public Works and Services, in charge of G/J Néstor Reverol.









Venezuela gives shelter to a symbol of Basque life

Tree of Gernika sapling planted in Generalissimo Francisco de Miranda Recreation Park

Ministry People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), planted a "Tree of Gernika' Generalissimo de Miranda Francisco Recreation Park, east of Greater Caracas.

The "Tree of Gernika", symbolic of Biscay, Basque Country, is world famous for its location and historical representation. It is located in the town of Gernika and is remembered for the bombing carried out by the German and Italian air forces in 1937, in support of Franco during the Spanish Civil War.

The Consulate General of Venezuela in Bilbao, the General Assembly of Biscay and the Basque community in the country, expressed their interest in bringing the "Tree of Gernika" to Venezuela, as it represents an important political and social symbol,

which has made it a distinctive symbol in the

The head of the Minec, Josué Lorca, was in the activity accompanied by the Minister of Culture, Villegas; Ernesto Venezuelan Čonsul Bilbao, Glenna Cabello; the Vice Minister for Europe, Franklin Ramírez and the General Director Integration and International Affairs of the Minec, Miguel Serrano.

Lorca emphasized that "the 'Tree of Gernika' means for you history, life, resistance against death, against hate, against fascism, for us it means an incentive, a push to also continue walking the path you are walking".

He warned that the world is facing new forms of domination, of colonialism, "we feel very honored to receive this

symbol, because as our Vice Chancellor said, part of the human essence is composed by the symbologies", expressed

Likewise, the Vice Minister Europe, Franklin Ramirez, said he extended greetings to the entire community residing in Venezuela and thanked the support to this initiative of planting this son of an emblem of the spirit of the resistance of the people of Gernika.

"In the construction of national identities, symbols play a fundamental role, they are the ones that unite us around the sense of being and belonging," Ramirez emphasized.

A survivor of the bombings of the Spanish Civil War residing in the country, born in Gernika, assured that she does

remember the bombings at all, but I remember when I arrived in Venezuela and saw the Avila and I said, I have enough with that mountain, it is the most beautiful thing that Caracas has, I am grateful for your visit, I am Gernikesa, even though I am Venezuelan, after 70 years I am still Gernikesa".

The president of the Basque Center in Caracas, Ibane Azpiritxaga, indicated that "like many who arrived in this country, this tree arrives as a well received foreigner. Venezuela will know how to give it shelter and will make this land its own. Planting this tree means a lot to all of us, perhaps for different reasons, that is why we must take care of it so that it allows us to remember those reasons why we are here today".
