More than 20 thousand men and women prepared for combat

Unified Command against Forest Fires Activated



They will ensure to prevent and combat forest fires throughout the national territory

From the Generalissimo Francisco de Miranda Air Base (La Carlota) and with the presence of the People's Power Minister for Ecosocialism, Josué Lorca, and the head of Internal Relations, Justice and Peace, and Vice President for Citizen Security, Admiral in Chief Remigio Ceballos Ichaso, the Unified Forest Fire Command was activated.

The body is an instance that guarantees the coordinated action of all the members of the National Risk System, with the aim of preventing and combating forest fires throughout the national territory.

The figure of the command is

made up of the Forest Firefighters, Park Rangers, Civil Protection (PC), Firefighters, Strategic Operational Command of the Bolivarian National Armed Forces (Ceofanb), National Parks Institute (Inparques), Bolivarian National Guard and the Bolivarian National Militia.

In this regard, Minister Lorca indicated that as usual as every year, the Ministry joins the national effort to establish the Fire Command, in which all the bodies that have to do with the Risk Management System participate.

"The Ministry for Ecosocialism makes part of these men and women available to the command, so that they put their technical and scientific

skills, for the hand-to-hand combat of forest fires," he said.

He added that "we must report, very responsibly, that due to the Niña year in large part, we have had a 56% decrease in forest events between 2020 compared to 2021".

"We have made progress, together with the National Experimental Security University (Unes), in the training of new forest firefighters and park rangers, as part of the first response to protect all protected areas", he said.

He added that "let us remember that the protected areas in Venezuela cover 28% of the territory, if we talk about National Parks, Natural Monuments and high protection figures, and they are almost 50% if we refer to the security zones and Areas Under the Regime of Special Administration (Abrae)".

"Protected areas are very important because they contain all the hydrographic basins, communication systems and the good life of our people rests because tourism is developed," he assured.

He stressed that "all the security forces that are related to the Vice Ministry of Risk Management, to which the Ministry for Ecosocialism is added, guarantee the protection of all the green areas of the country and the

good life of Venezuelans".

For his part, the Chief Admiral Remigio Ceballos Ichaso, asserted that the purpose of the meeting is to integrate the entire Risk Management System and work hand in hand with the Ministry for Ecosocialism (Minec).

"With the Risk Management System, we are preparing ourselves with the activation of this Unified Command to Combat Forest Fires at the national level," he pointed out.

Ceballos stated that "the La Niña phenomenon will increase the rains starting in April, however the highest temperatures are going to be between January and March, which indicates the high possibility of fires breaking out. That is why we are preparing for those events".

"The Risk Management System is conformed by more than 20 thousand men, who are fully dedicated to work in all spaces of the Republic, to attend all kinds of events", he

said.

He recalled that "as article 55 of the Constitution says, the Venezuelan State works to fight against the risks, threats and vulnerabilities that may occur, acting with the citizen security organs".

"In the end, the search for a protected nature, a balanced environment, that we can enjoy, children, adolescents and older adults, all Venezuelan citizens," he said.

Species will be evaluated by the veterinary staff

Caricuao Zoo receives specimen of Cunaguaro

Personnel from the General Directorate of Biological Diversity of the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), mobilized a Cunaguaro specimen from Anzoátegui state to the facilities of the Caricuao Zoo in Caracas.

The animal, a female weighing six kilograms and a year and a half old, was sheltered in the areas of the Ecosocialist Territorial Unit (UTEC) of Anzoátegui, after the loss of her mother at the hands of hunters who wanted to keep her as a pet.

For this reason, the young could not return to the natural environment, because it has not developed enough habits to defend itself from other species, nor to feed itself.

The cunaguaro arrived in Caricuao in very good condition



He arrived in Caricuao in very good condition and will be under constant veterinary evaluation

and will be under constant evaluation by the veterinary doctor, who will give instructions for feeding and quarantine.

Once the quarantine has

elapsed, the animal will go to an exhibition area, where it is expected to be incorporated into the Cunaguaro conservation program in Venezuela.

Minister Lorca led the Anniversary

Generalissimo Francisco de Miranda Park: 61 years recreating the people of Caracas



MINEC and INPARQUES authorities celebrated the 61st anniversary of the Generalissimo Francisco de Miranda Recreational Park

With a succulent cake, many fruits that the attendees tasted and a good number of songs, the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec) and the entity attached to the National Parks Institute (Inparques), celebrated the 61st anniversary of the Generalissimo Francisco Recreational Park of Miranda, in the east of Caracas.

The head of the Minec and president of Inparques, Josué Lorca, was present at the event, who made a tour of the place that includes 85 hectares to verify the progress of the rehabilitation works, while taking the opportunity to make important announcements.

"We continue working on the rehabilitation. We have been working for more than two years, in which we have recovered the water wells, we

built a new irrigation system for the boating lake that we are activating as of this moment, because the dry season has already entered in Venezuela", he said.

He indicated that the Big Eight Irrigation System, which covers

a large part of this recreation space, "is activated and works every other day, so that everyone can continue enjoying the greenery of the space".

"The areas of the courts are recovered. The 20 courts in parking lot 1 and 2 are painted and illuminated. We are reactivating parking lot No. 2 so that all those who come to exercise, recreate and enjoy themselves have a place to park", he said.

Lorca pointed out that parking lot No. 2 was occupied by units and personnel of the auxiliary water system of the Capital District.

"We have made a rearrangement with the Bolivarian National Guard (GNB), the People's Guard. On this birthday we want to give the good news to all Caracas

and Mirandinos : We are working on the rehabilitation of the historic entrance of Generalissimo Francisco de Miranda, which had been closed due to the Metro works, so that in the coming weeks all users can access for his historic entrance", he explained.

The Minister added that work is also being done on the reconstruction of the banking system, which reaches "more than 200 benches, so that everyone can be comfortable, in addition to the refurbishment of the piñateros kiosks ".

A workshop on vermiculture holded in Guarenas

As part of the training activities carried out by the Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism (Minec), students from the Menca I Educational Unit in the town of Guarenas, in the state of Miranda, received a workshop on vermiculture.

37 students and nine teachers participated.

Five actions to conserve wildlife

1. In situ conservation

It consists of preserving ecosystems and landscapes in their natural state to allow the presence of umbrella species and the development of the distinctive characteristics of each element within the ecosystem.



2. Ex situ conservation

It is a way of reincorporating species that have previously been extracted from their natural habitats. It occurs particularly with fauna, with animals that are handed over voluntarily or that have been confiscated from illegal trafficking networks.



3. Environmental education

The benefits of having informed communities that understand the importance and benefits of conserving wildlife and their habitats have been proven countless times. This generates positive attitudes and skills in daily life that redound to benefits for the species.



4. Institutional strengthening for protected areas

It is important that at the national, regional and local levels there are personnel trained in the conservation of species and that, likewise, this is supported by public and private institutions that prioritize the conservation objectives of protected area systems.



5. Participatory planning

When management strategies are designed in a participatory manner with communities living in potential habitats –places where more species possibly inhabit–, sustainable production systems can be developed that benefit them economically while being friendly to the environment.
